

Corner to corner

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Brian Hagen, Bryan TX A58003

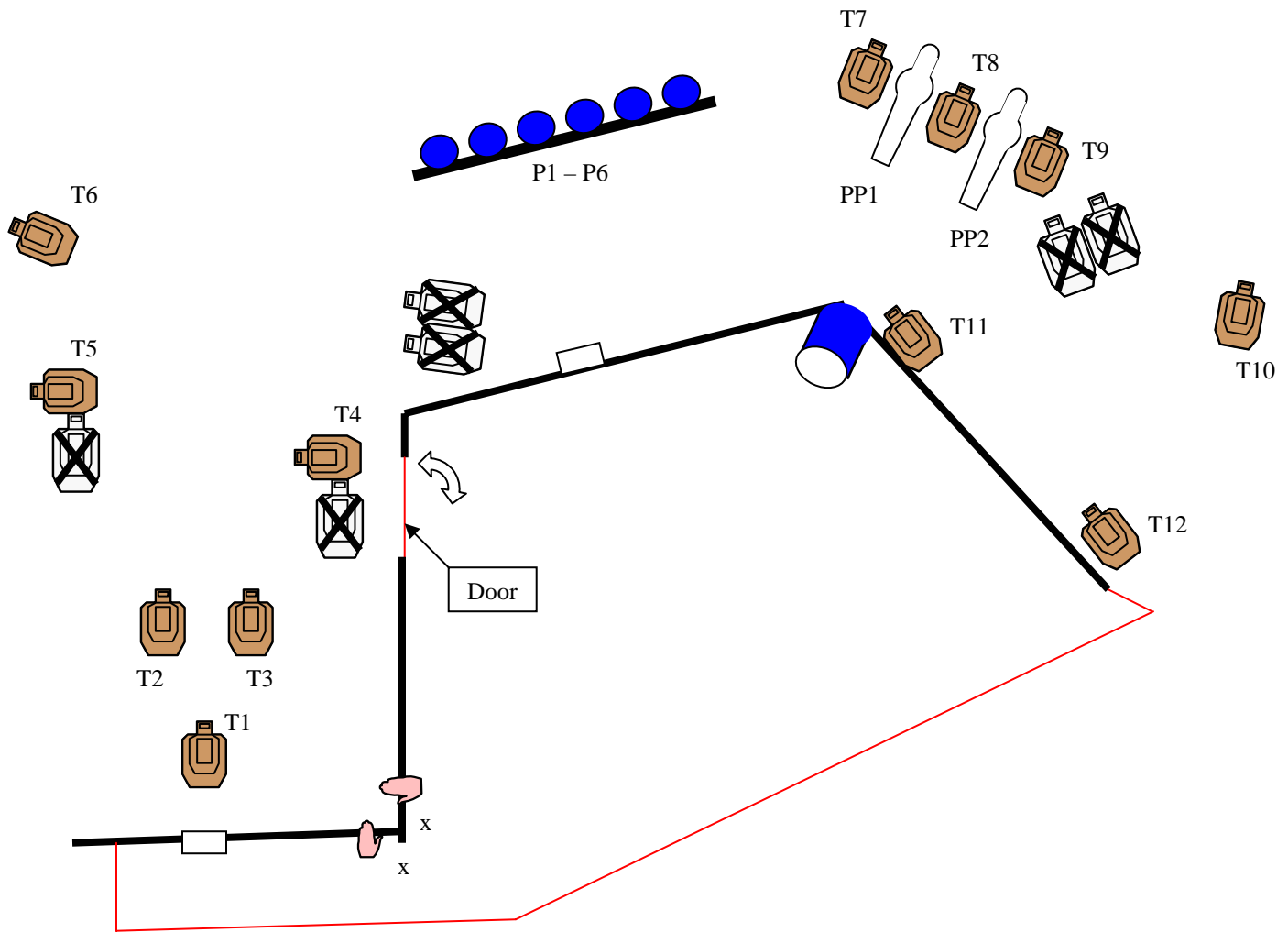
START POSITION: Standing on the X's with palms flat on the walls wearing oven mits, one hand on either side of the corner. Hands can not be on the same wall. Gun loaded in holster per ready condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal engage each target as they become visible while remaining within the fault lines. Steel must fall to score. T7 – T9, PP1 & PP2 must be engaged through the barrel.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points
TARGETS: 12 IPSC, 2 PP, 6 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: T1, T4 & T12 are 45 degree targets.

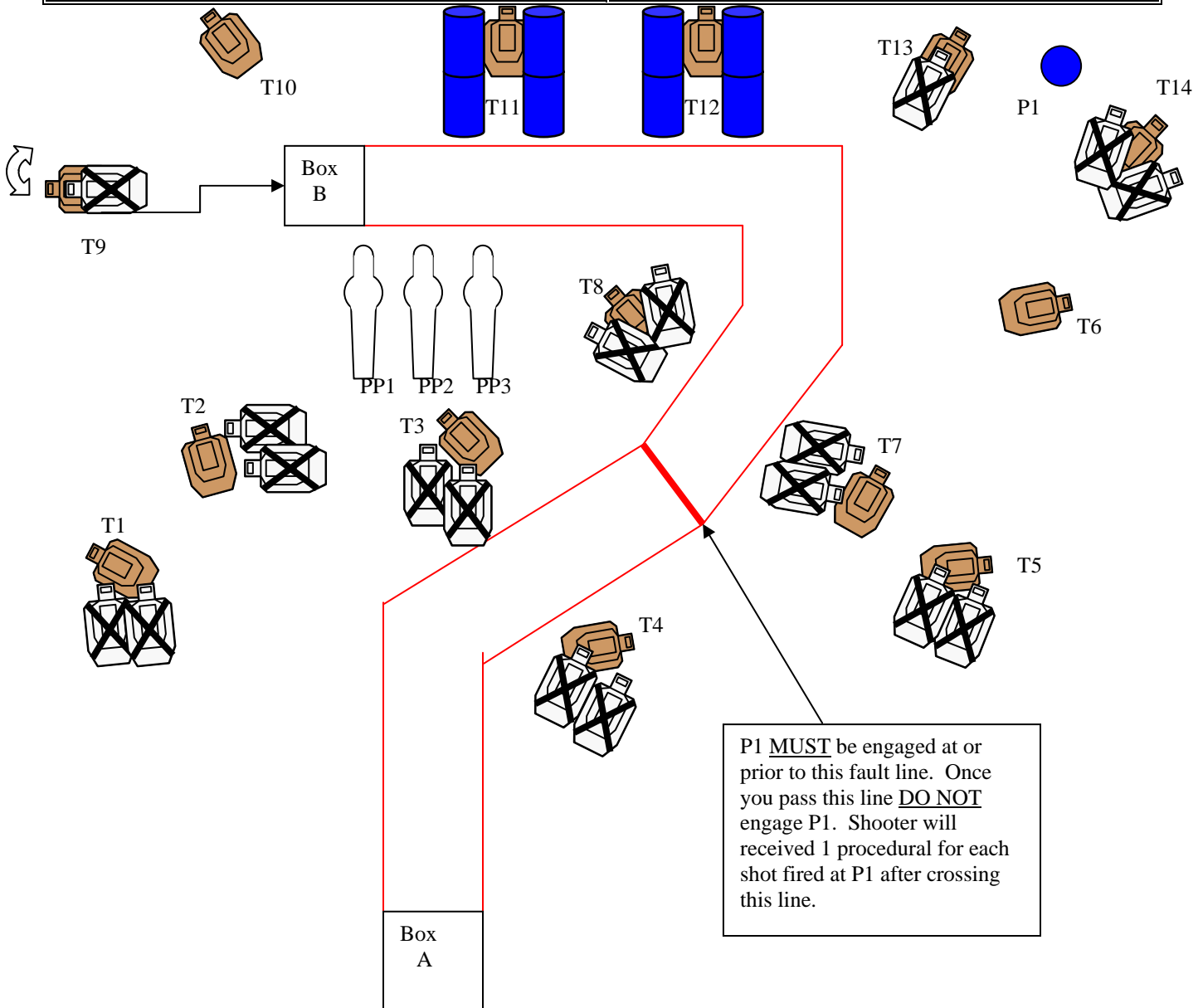
START POSITION: Standing in Box A hands relaxed at sides facing down range. Gun is loaded in holster per ready condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2. All extra ammo on shooters belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal engage each target as they become visible. PP1 – PP3 must be shot while in Box A. P1 must be shot at or prior to the fault line in the shooting area. Steel must fall to score.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points
TARGETS: 14 IPSC, 3 PP, 1 Plate
SCORED HITS: Best per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: T3 & T8 are 45 degree targets. T9 is bear trap target activated by box B.

RO NOTES: If P1 is engaged after the fault line shooter will receive 1 procedural for each shot fired at P1.

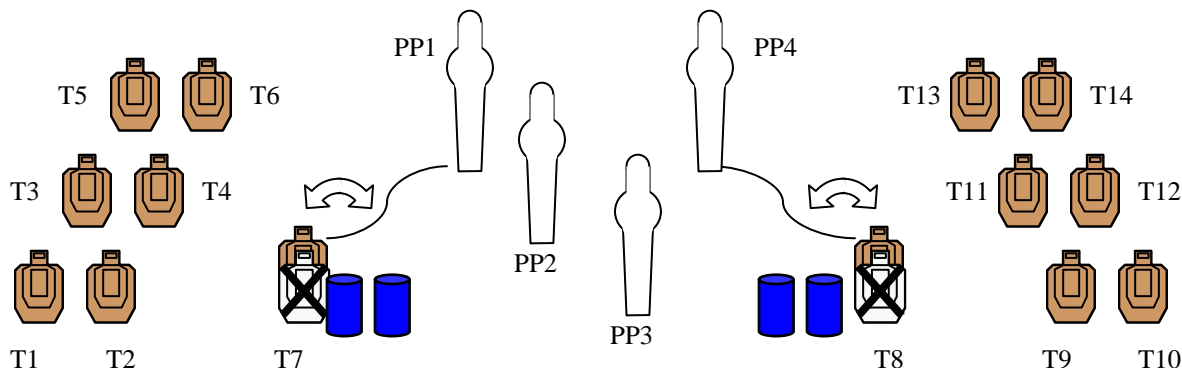
START POSITION: Standing in Box A facing down range with hands in surrender position above respective shoulders. Gun is loaded in holster per ready condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal engage targets as they become visible while remaining in Box A. Steel MUST fall to score. PP1 will activate T7 and PP4 will activate T8. T7 & T8 must be activated before engaging the target.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points
TARGETS: 14 IPSC, 4 PP
SCORED HITS: Best per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10

SETUP NOTES: T1 – T6 & T9 – T14 will be off set from target behind each one. T1, T2, T9, T10 will be set close to ground, T3, T4, T11, T12 set bottom of target even with top of previous target 12” back. T5, T6, T13, T14 set bottom of target even with top of previous target 12” back

PP1 will activate T7 and PP4 will activate T8

Payne's Pain

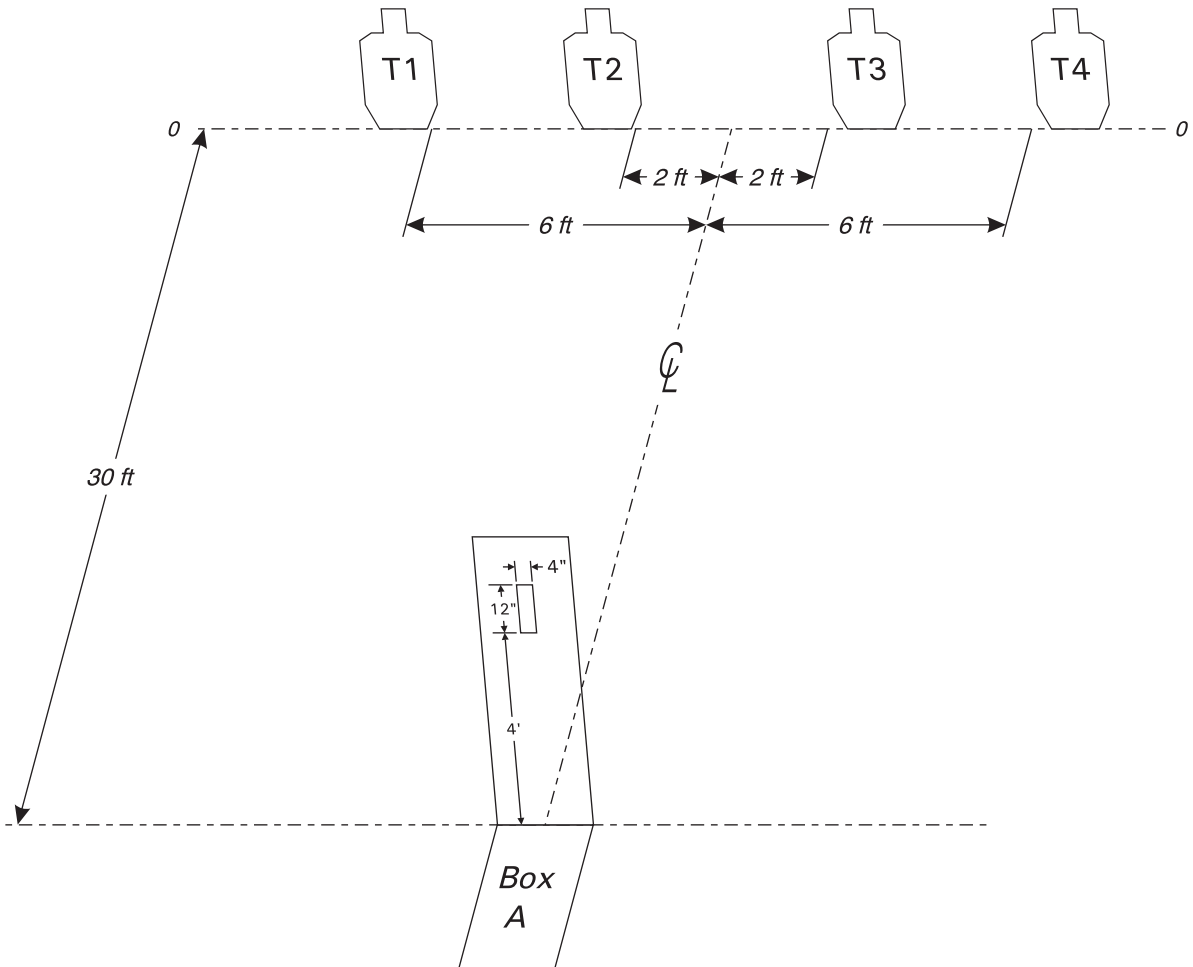
START POSITION: Standing in Box A, palms of both hands flat against the respective sides of the barricade. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, from Box A engage T1-T4 with only one round per target around either side of the barricade. Then make a mandatory reload and from Box A engage T1-T4 with only one round per target through Port B, then make a mandatory reload and from Box A, engage T1-T4 with only one round per target from the remaining side of the barricade.

SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 4 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 3/paper
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.
Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Barricade is 2 feet wide by 6 feet high. Box is 2 feet wide by 3 feet long. Port B is 4 inches wide and 12 inches high. Bottom of port is 4 feet above ground.
