STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon audible start signal engage each target, T1 thru T13, as they become visible staying within fault lines. PP1 thru PP3 and P1 & P2 **must** be shot thru the barrel.

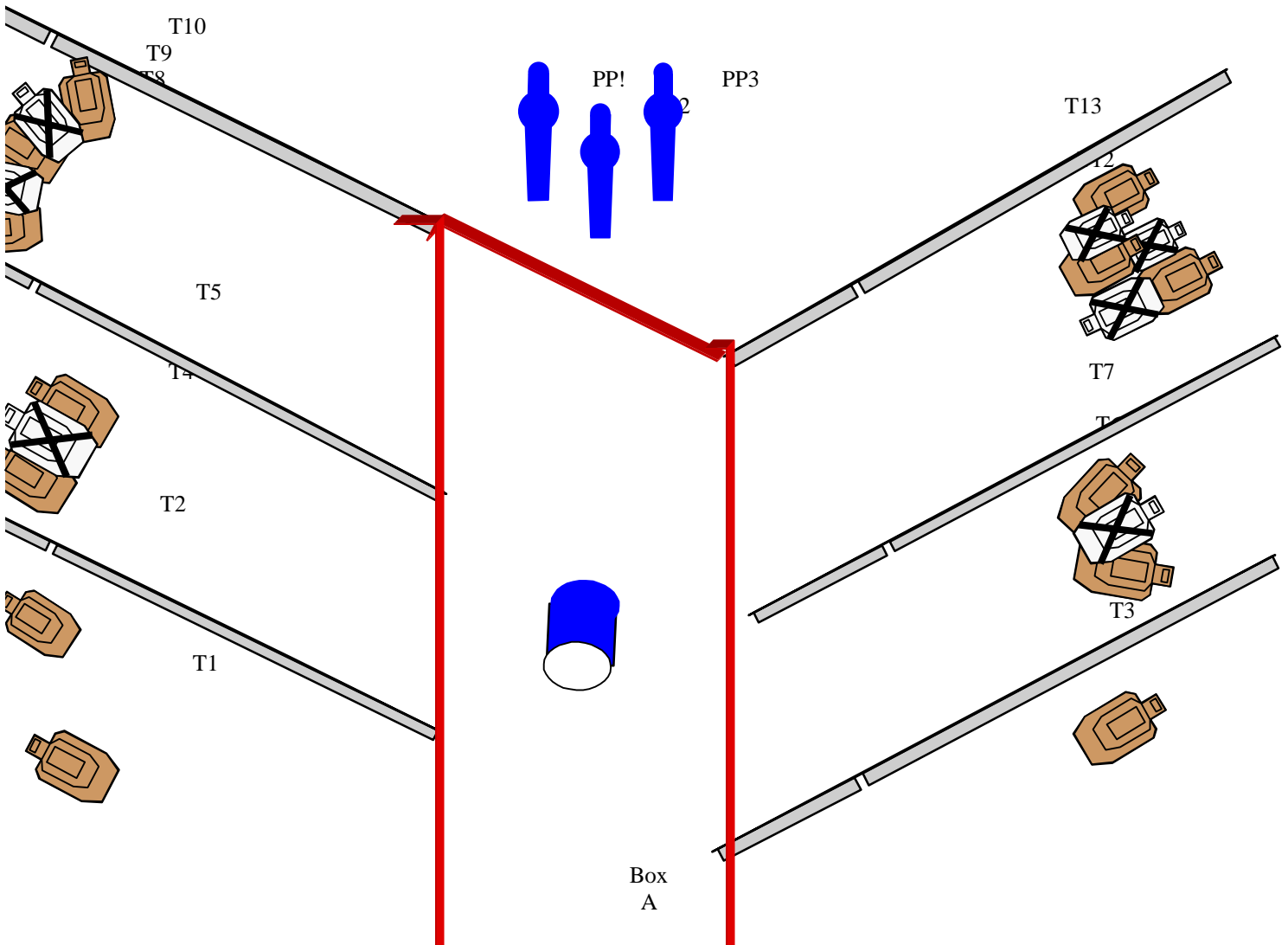

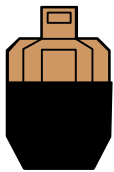
START POSITION: Standing in box A with toes touching the back of the box with shooter's back to the targets, Hands above shoulders, gun loaded and in holster in ready condition per rule 8.1.1 & 8.1.2

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal while standing in box A engage all targets as they become visible. Steel plate must fall to score and all plates must fall from star to count.

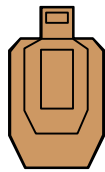

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

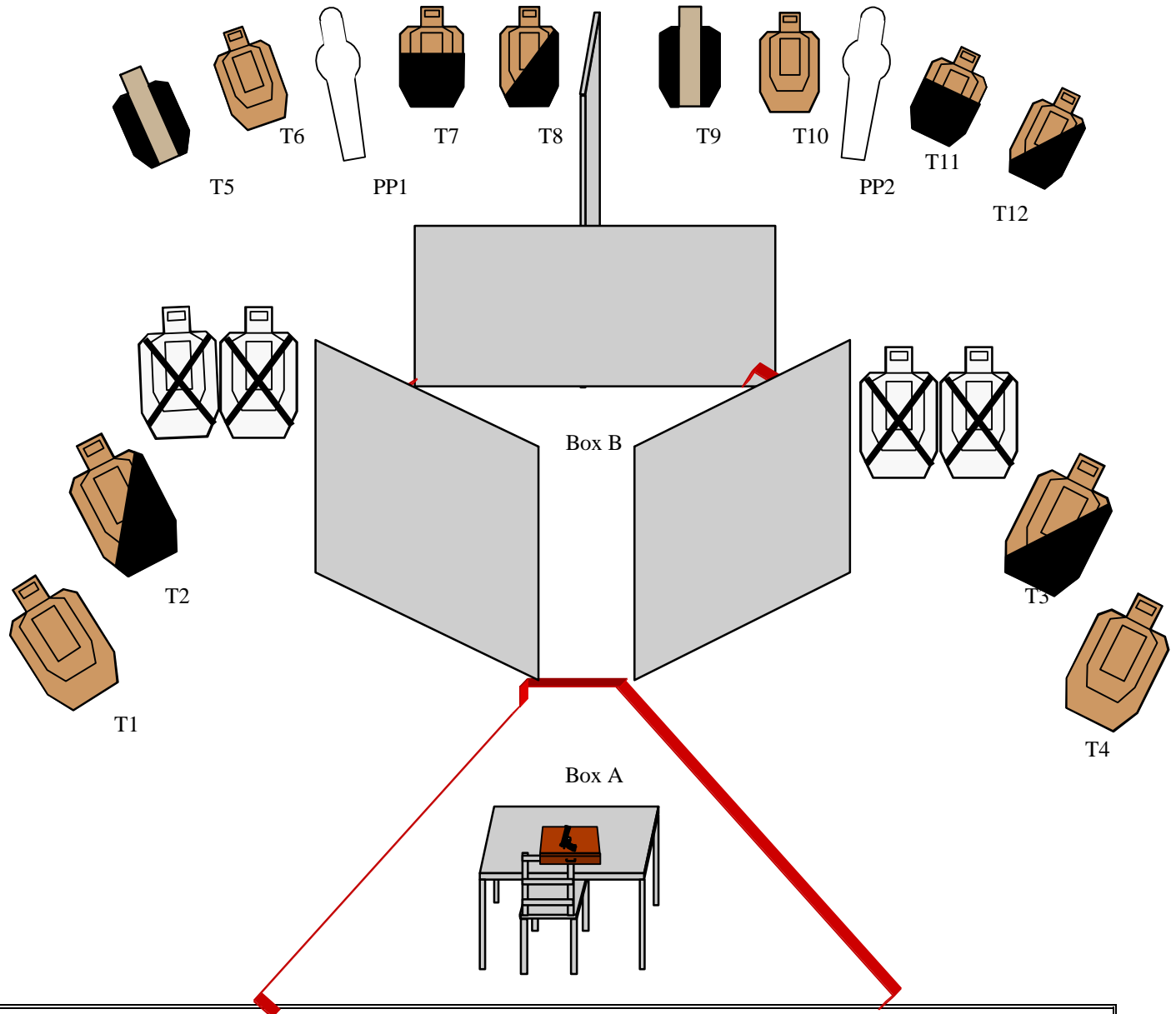
START POSITION: Setting at the table with knees under the table and hands flat on the table. Gun is unloaded laying inside the brief case unsupported with lid closed and latched. All ammo on shooters belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal remove gun from closed and latched brief case, load and engage each target with 2 rounds each as they become visible from inside the fault lines. T1 thru T4 must be shot from behind the table. T5 thru T12 and PP1 & PP2 must be shot from with in fault lines in **Area B ONLY**. PP1 & PP2 must fall to score.

Peek-A-Boo No-shoots

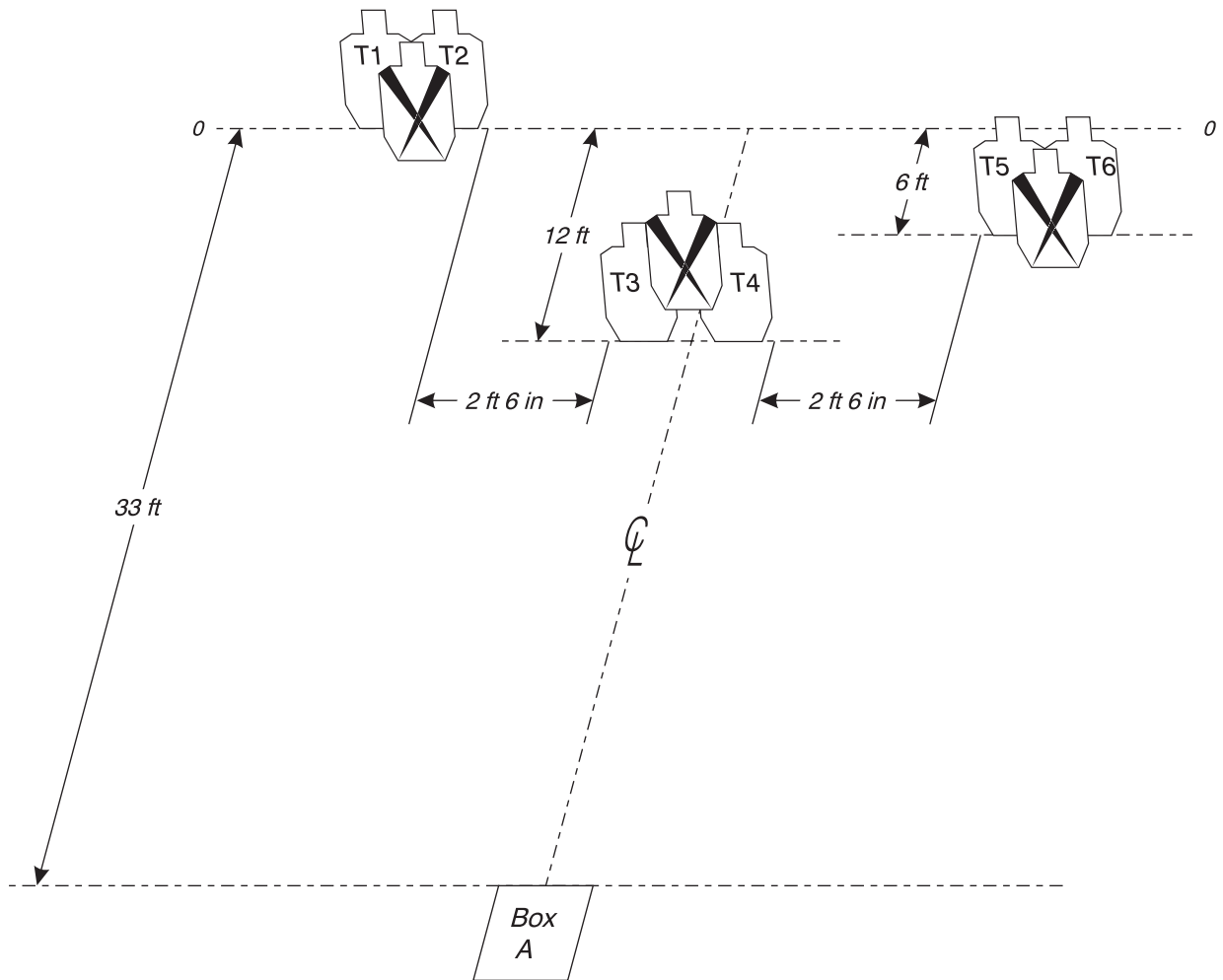
START POSITION: Standing in Box A facing targets with both arms hanging relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, from Box A, engage T1-T6 with one round each in any order, perform a mandatory reload and from Box A, engage T1-T6 with one round each target.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.
Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: Set targets T3 and T4 to 3 feet high at shoulders. T1, T2, T5, and T6 are set to 5 feet high at shoulders. Set no-shoot at T3-T4 array so lower shoulder corner is even with top of targets. Top of no-



shoots on the other two arrays are set to lower shoulder corner of the target arrays. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet. No-shoot on target T3 and T4 is centered on center line. T1, T2 and T5, T6 are butted edge to edge.
