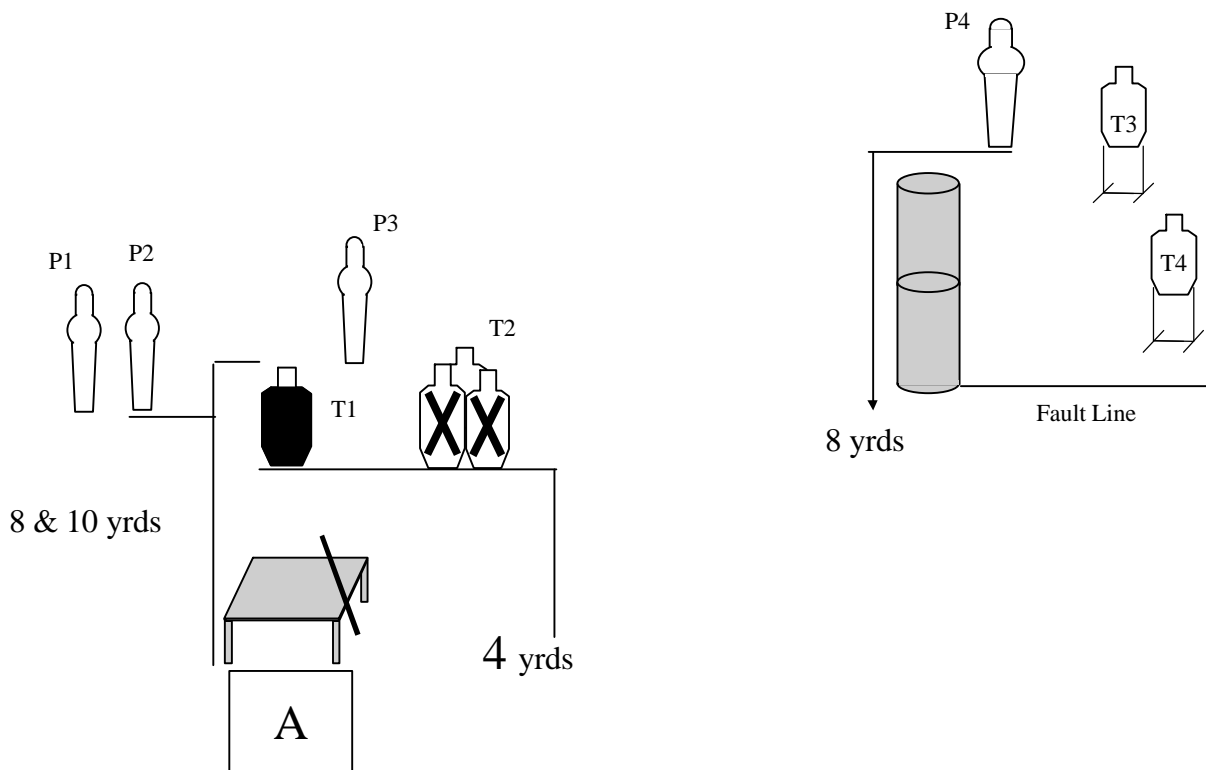
START POSITION: In box A, pistol loaded and holstered. Leaning on Pool Table, stick in each hand simulating shot.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage P1-3 and T1 & T2 while holding pool stick. Place pistol On Safe or Empty on pool table and retrieve revolver from between barrels by striking upper barrel with pool stick. Engage P4 and T3 & 4 freestyle.

SCORING: Comstock, 12 rounds
TARGETS: IPSC, PP
SCORED HITS: 2 Best per IPSC, Steel Down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10

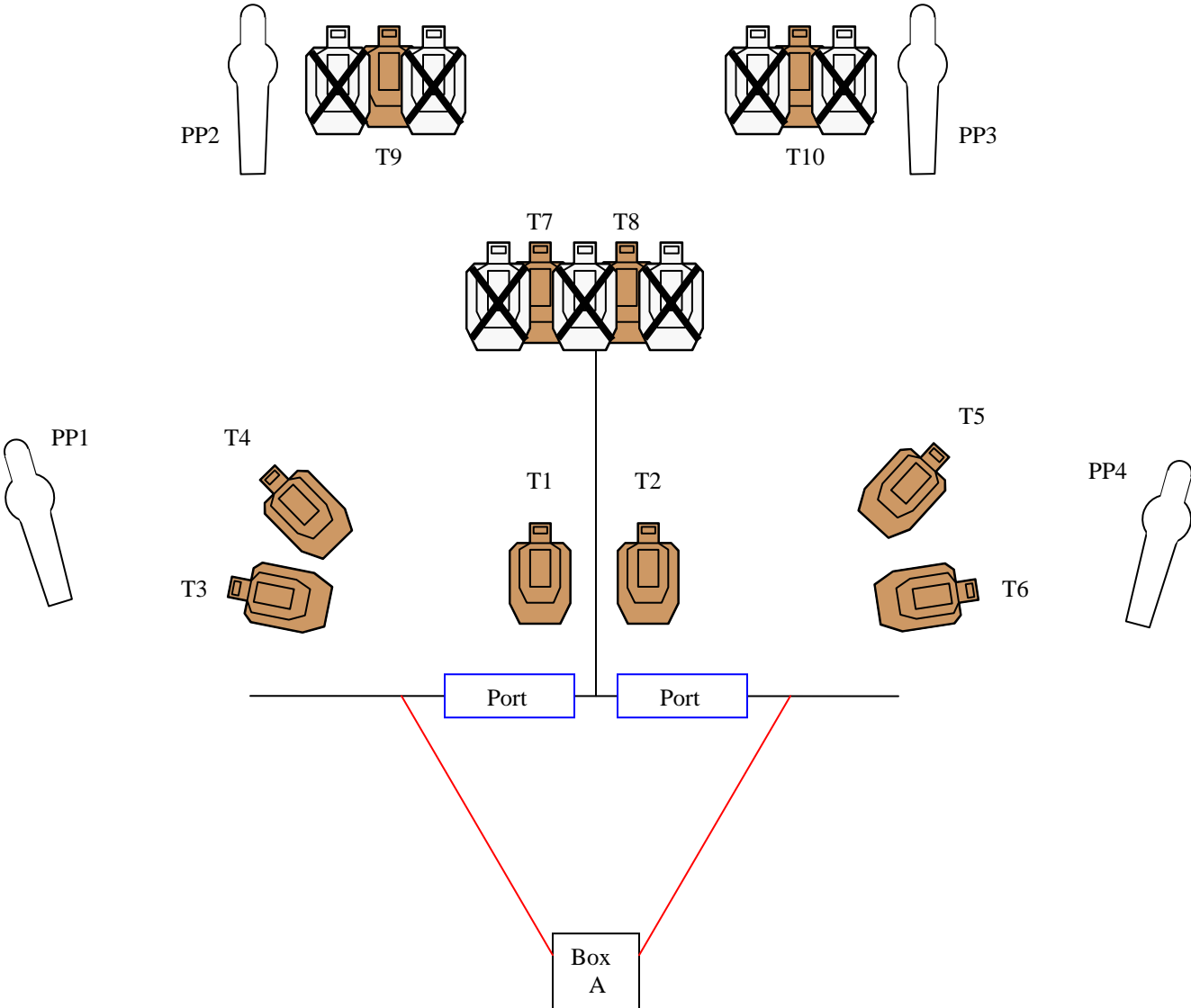

START POSITION: Standing in box A facing up range with hands above respective shoulders in surrender position. Gun loaded and holstered per ready condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2.	
STAGE PROCEDURE Upon start signal from box A turn and engage PP1 & PP4, they must be shot from box. Then engage each target as they become visible remaining in the fault lines. Steel must fall to score.	SCORING SCORING: Comstock, 24 rounds, 120 points TARGETS: 10 IPSC, 4 PP, USP SCORED HITS: Best per IPSC, steel down = 1A START-STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Procedural. -10 No-shoot hit. -10 Miss. -10

Shootin up the Saloon

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Brian Hagen, A58003, June 2008

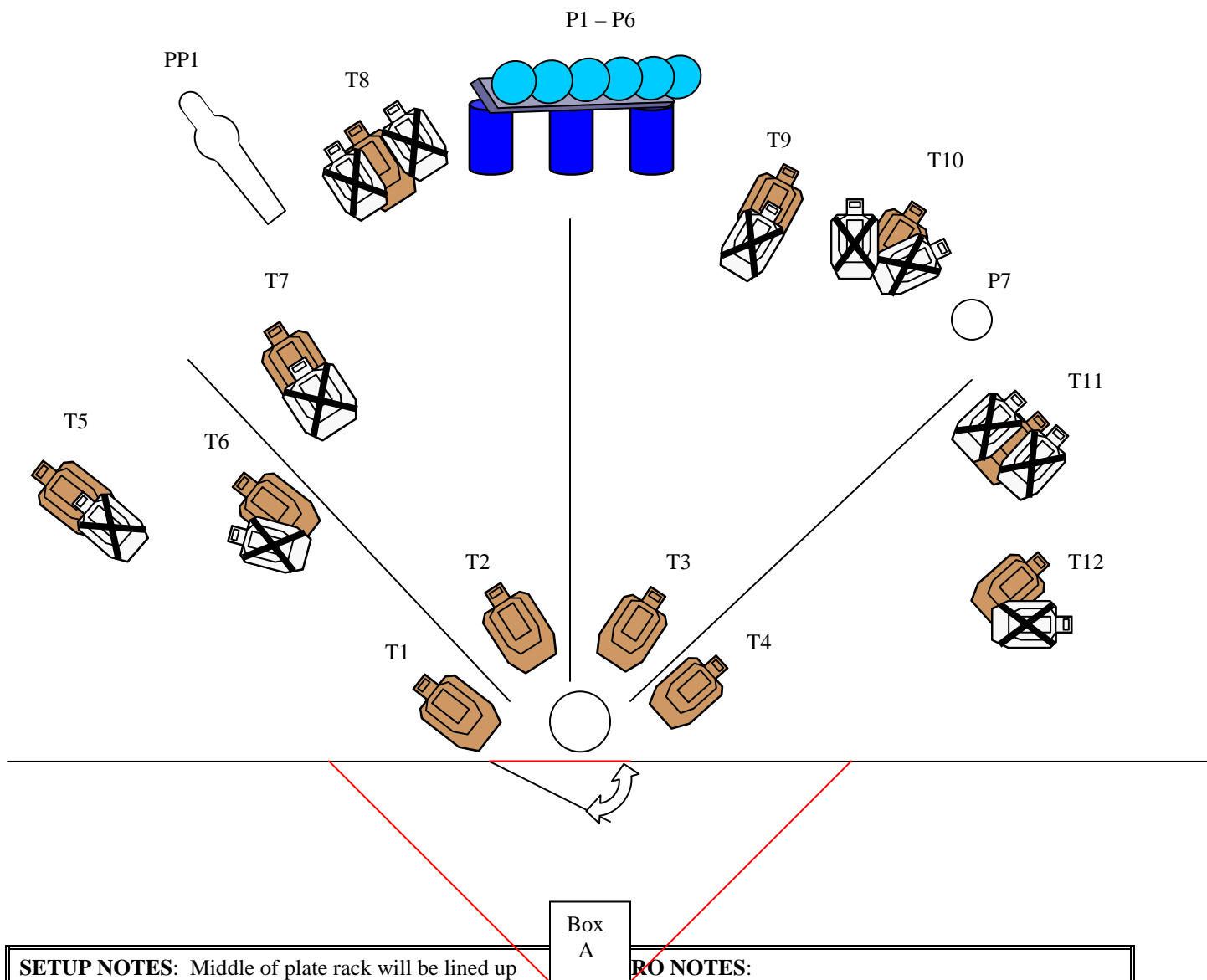
START POSITION: Standing in Box A shooter will be holding a whiskey bottle in one hand and shot glass in other as you would be pouring a shot, facing up range with toes touching back of box A and shoulders square to the box. Gun will be lying on the barrel inside the door unloaded and unsupported. ALL ammunition is from shooters belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal shooter will place the whiskey bottle and shot glass in the bucket on top of the barrel inside the saloon, retrieve their weapon and shoot targets as they become visible while remaining within the fault lines. All steel must fall to score.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points
TARGETS: 12 IPSC, 1 PP, 7 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Middle of plate rack will be lined up with middle wall. P1 will be set at 4' off ground and P2 will be 2' off ground.

Night Moves

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** John Wells — Modifications by US Design Team

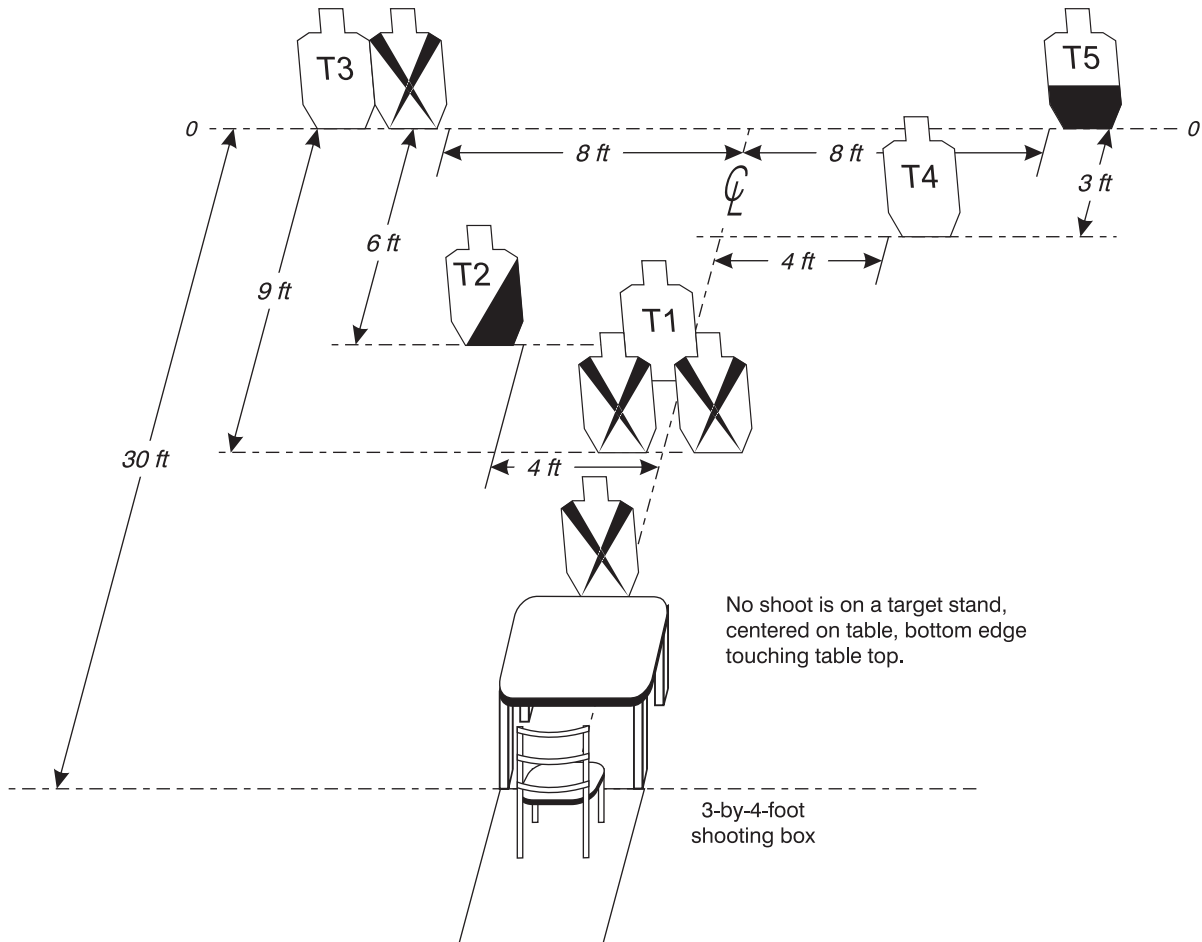
START POSITION: Sitting behind table with knees under edge, fingers of hands interlaced in lap, back touching the back rest of chair, feet flat on ground. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

- String 1. Upon start signal, from behind the table engage T1 with only two rounds and T2-T5 with only one round per target.
 - String 2. Upon start signal, from behind the table engage T1 with only two rounds and T2-T5 with only one round per target, strong hand only.
 - String 3. Upon start signal, transfer gun to weak hand and from behind table using weak hand only, engage T1 with only two rounds and T2-T5 with only one round per target.
- Jams may be cleared with both hands.

SCORING

- SCORING:** Virginia Count, 18 rounds, 90 points
- TARGETS:** 5 IPSC
- SCORED HITS:** Best 6 on T1, Best 3 T2-T5
- START - STOP:** Audible - Last Shot
- PENALTIES:** Per current edition of USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.



No shoot is on a target stand, centered on table, bottom edge touching table top.

3-by-4-foot shooting box

SETUP NOTES: Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. T1 is centered on range centerline, T2 is 4 feet left of centerline. Hard cover on T5 comes to bottom of A zone. The shoulders of the no-shoots at T1 are even with the bottom of the A zone. The table is 3



feet by 3 feet with a 3-foot-wide-by-4-foot deep shooting box for the chair. Top of table should be no higher than 28 inches. Hard cover on T2 runs diagonal from lower right shoulder to lower left bottom straight edge.
