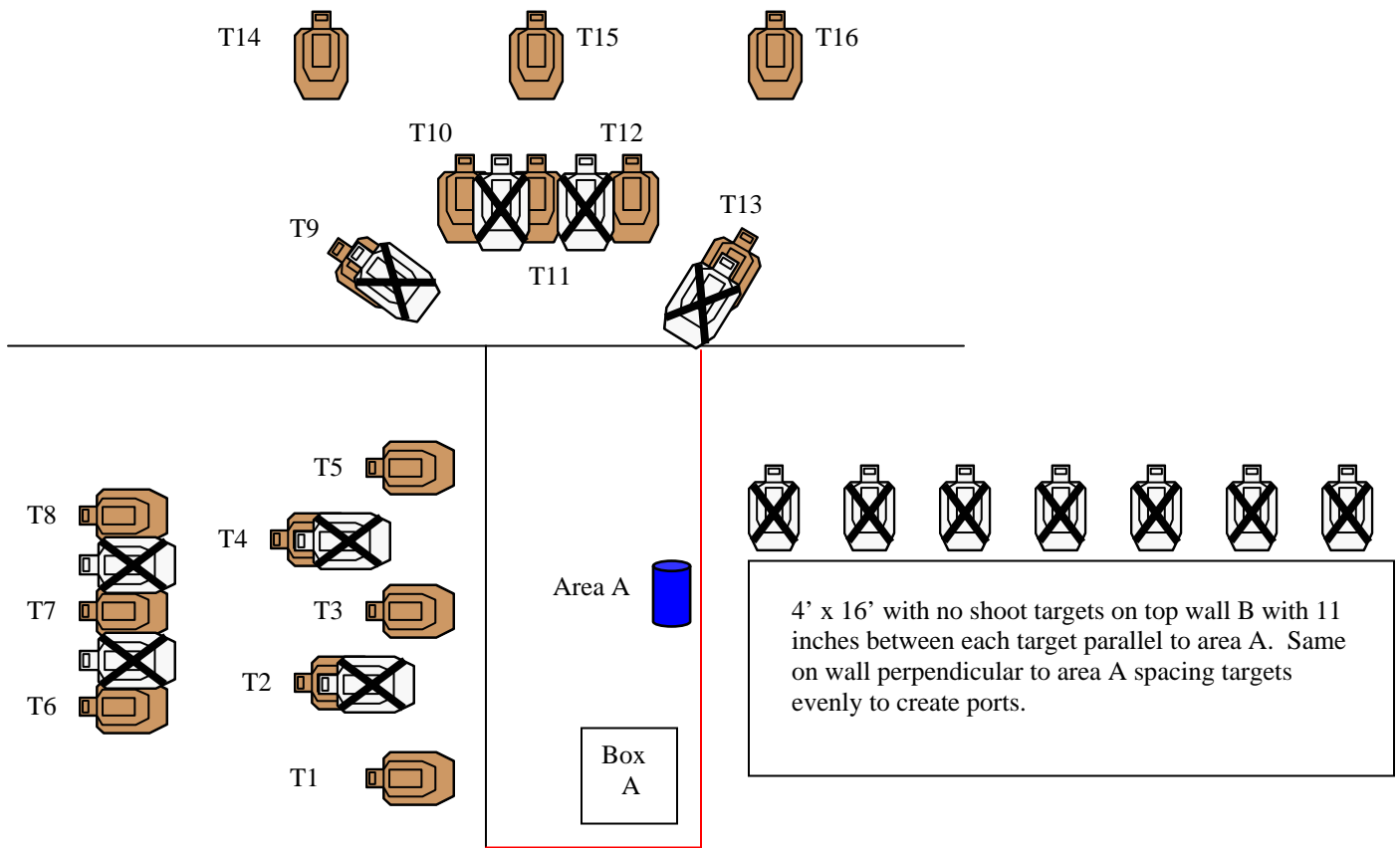
START POSITION: Standing in box A facing up range with hands above respective shoulders in surrender position. Gun unloaded and unsupported on barrel in area A. All ammo on shooters belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE

At start signal retrieve gun off barrel. Engage targets as they become visible remaining with in fault lines in Area A.

SCORED HITS: Best per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10

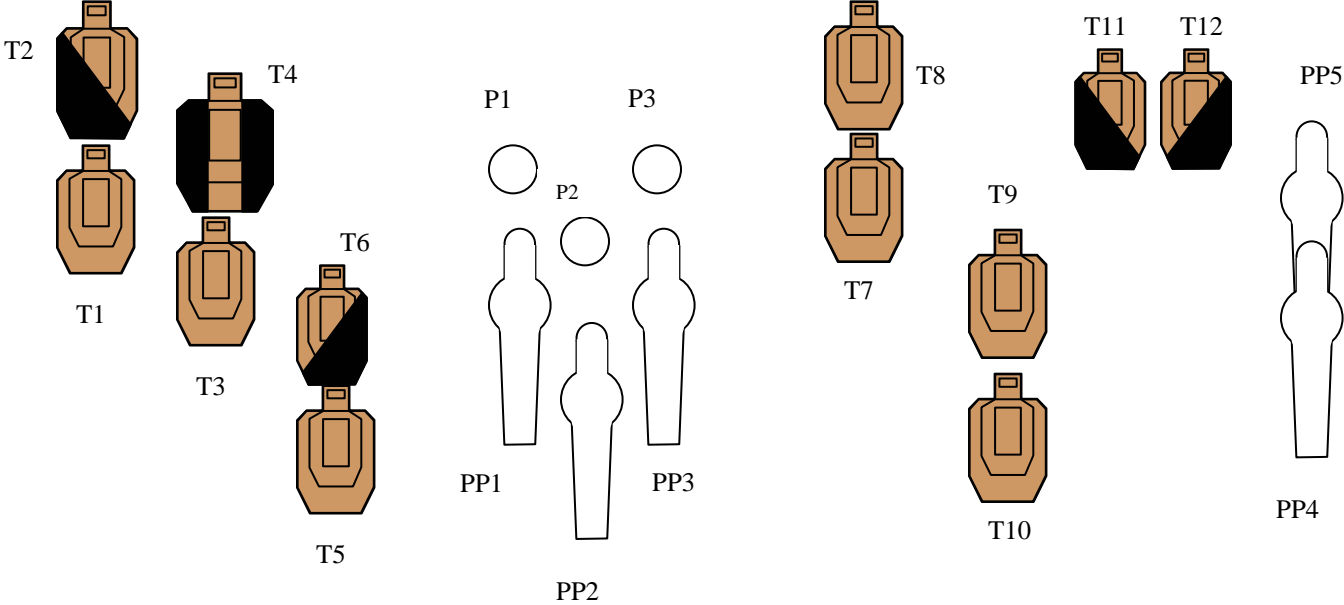
SETUP NOTES: All walls will be built to 4' in height. T1 – T5 and T9 – T 13 will be set at 45 degree from ground. T6 – T8 and T14 – T16 will be set at 2' 9" to top of target in vertical position.

PP1 – PP3 & P1 – P3 MUST be shot through the barrel while shooter remains behind the fault line. Steel must fall to score. 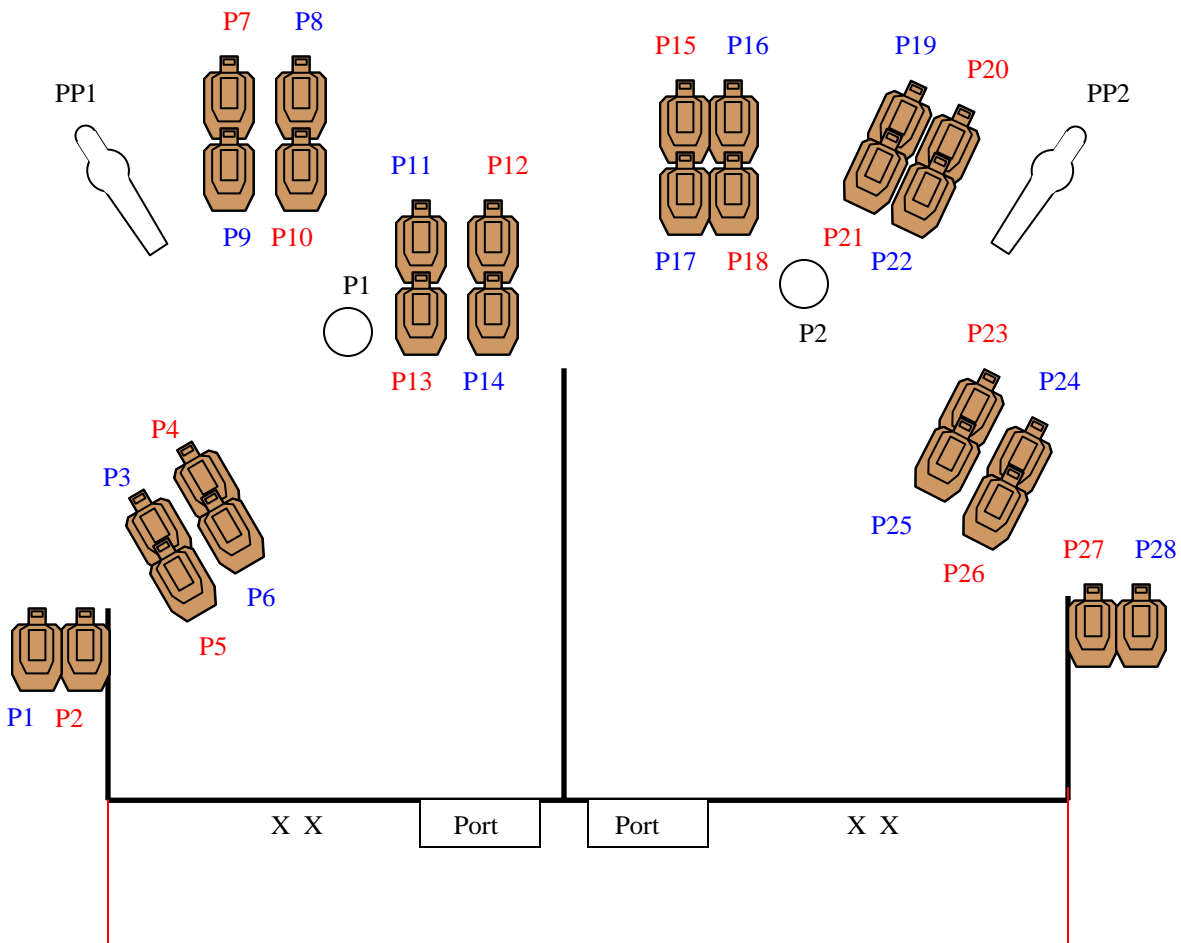
START POSITION: Standing in on X's of shooter choice facing up range with back flat against the wall shoulders touching the wall and hands above shoulders in surrender position. Gun loaded and holstered per ready condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal shooter will pick a colored poker chip from the hanging bucket. Shooter can not look in the bucket when picking out chip. Shooter will engage the color they choose only on the start side and will shoot the opposite color only on opposite side. All shots must be fired while remaining behind the fault line. Steel must fall to score.

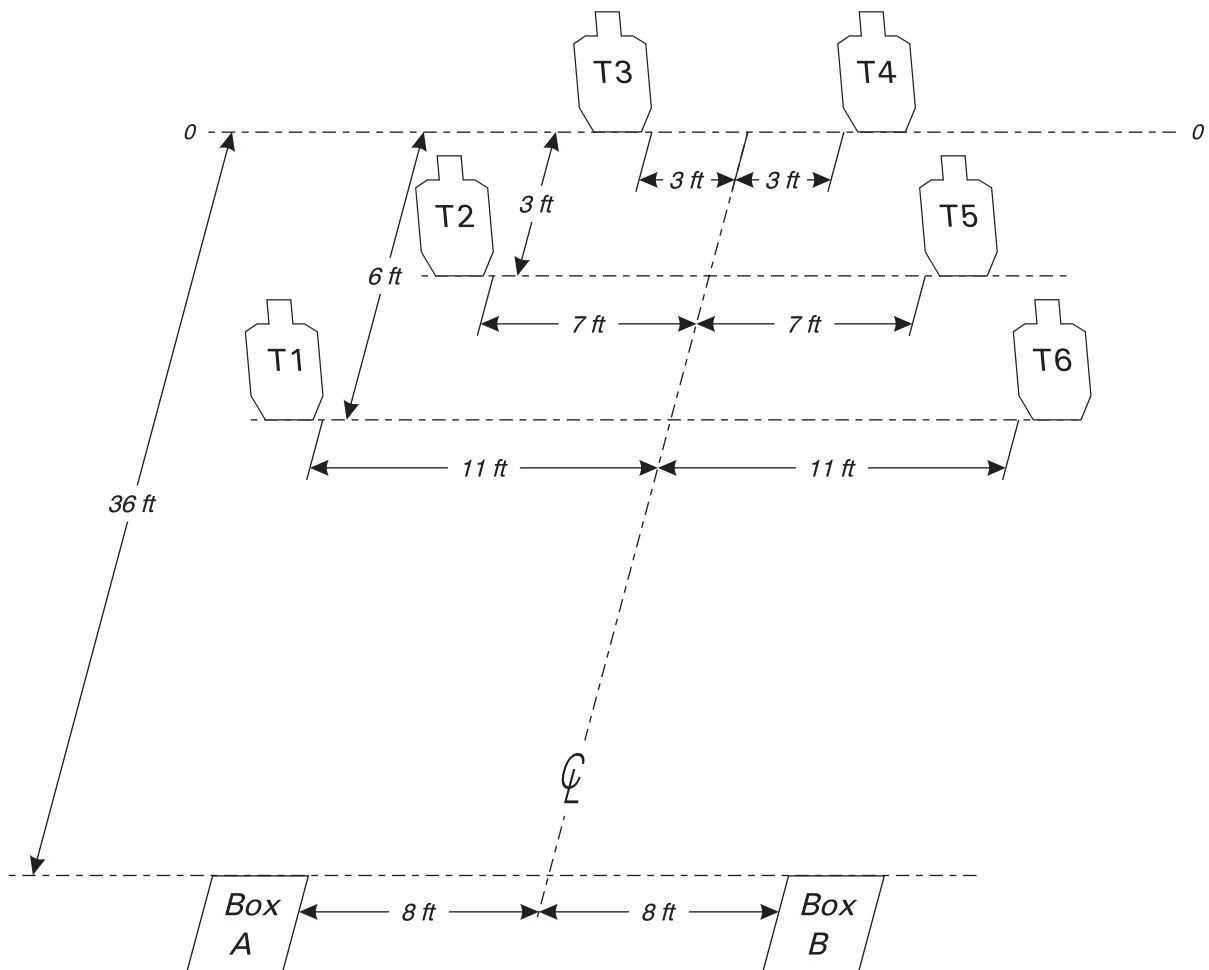

STAGE PROCEDURE

From Box A engage only T1-T3 with two rounds each.
From Box B engage only T4-T6 with two rounds each. Start in either Box A or Box B. Upon start signal, from the starting box engage the appropriate targets. Move to the remaining box and engage the appropriate targets.

SCORING: Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.



SETUP NOTES: Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Shooting boxes are 3 feet by 3 feet.
