Howdy folks & Happy Thanksgiving!

This Sunday, its time to shoot again! We have a great match this month from Paul S. as our match director. Paul has pulled together some very cool stages...I really like the shoot house, it's got two doors!

This stage will require you to engage targets while holding a flashlight that is oriented at the target. If you have neglected this aspect of your training in the past, its time to test a few things out... (check out our forum on-line for a discussion on flashlight techniques, I like the Sure-Fire/Rogers). For this stage you will be allowed to use your own flashlight, or you will be required to use the one provided. The light you use must be appropriate for use as a tactical light...none of these little AAA flashlights!

You will notice the new barricades and doors we are using have welded steel frames...Paul is building these for the club and combined with the walls of the same design from Jerry B. they are going to be a great improvement over the wooden ones we have used in the past. Thanks to Paul for that!

We also have a stage that incorporates color to determine which targets to engage. I like the layout of this stage, it should be fun. The classifier is a good one and we will also have a good old-fashioned steel speed stage that uses a Turkey shaped plate as the stop plate.

After we finish the match, we will have a version of the .22 LR side match we had last month (Steel Challenge style shoot-off) except it will be fired with .22 rifles at 50-75 feet. This outta be fun... I really like the side matches we have been having lately. I hope you all do as well. In December we will likely shoot a shotgun side match and perhaps a carbine in January.

Speaking of January...who wants to be Match Director? I am going to try something different in 2008. I'd like MD's to serve for 2 consecutive months. I think the learning curve will help with the second match after running the first and your creative juices can flow a little more when you have two matches to fill instead of just one. Give me some feedback on this...or just volunteer!

One other note: I have been asked (and I think it's a good idea) to see if we can collect some donations for the KBTX Food for Families Food Drive. Paul has told me he will be donating the proceeds from the Bar-B-Q pot at the match and I'll bring a box for canned goods. We all have a can or two of something in the pantry that we don't want to have too eat (here come the peas!), so bring it out and it will be donated to a good cause. Nobody but us will know we are doing this; but each of us will know. Good enough.

End With A Turkey

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Paul Schleider

START POSITION:

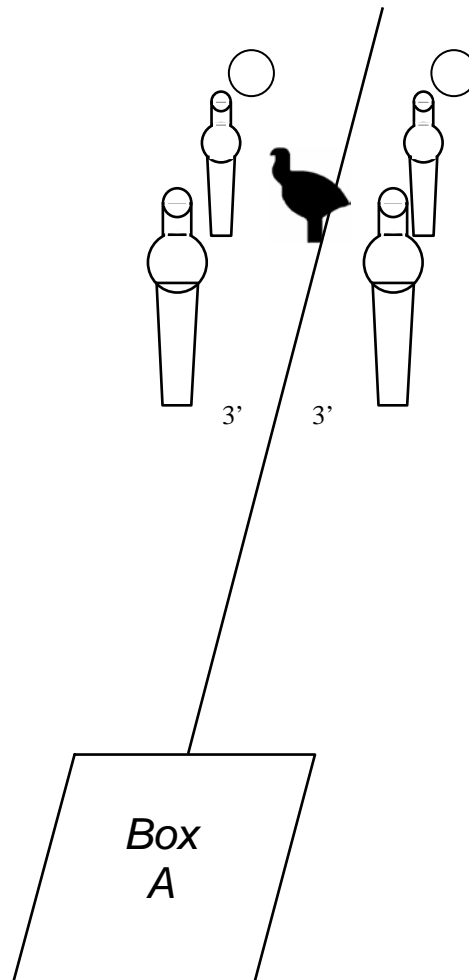
Standing in Box A, facing targets, both wrists above shoulders.

STAGE PROCEDURE

TURKEY IS STOP PLATE and must be engaged last
From Box A engage targets as they become visible.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 7 rounds, 25 points
TARGETS: PP, plate
SCORED HITS: Best per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible – Turkey Stop plate
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES:

Poppers set at 25' from edge of box.

Mini popper set up in directly behind popper and plate set up behind it. Space popper, mini-popper and plate so they are hidden from shooter until front target falls. Turkey set up even with mini popper.

RO NOTES:

Clearing the House

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Paul Schleider

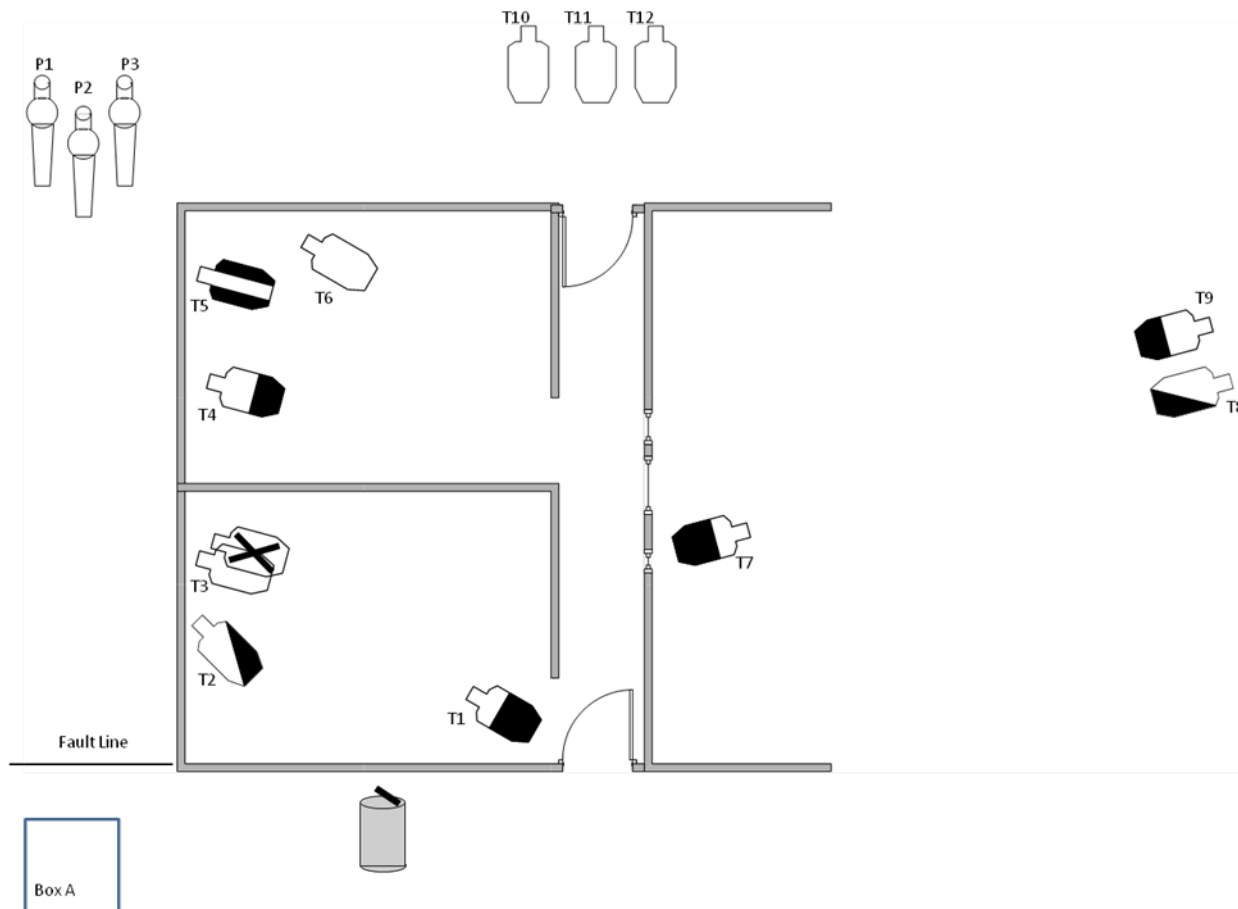
START POSITION: Standing erect in Box A, arms hanging naturally at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal engage targets as they become visible. Retrieve flashlight from barrel before entering "House". Flashlight must be pointed at target while engaging T1 – T6. Failure to point flashlight at target will incur 1 procedural per shot fired. T7-T9 must be engaged through one of the ports. T10-T12 may be engaged freestyle. Engaging a target through a "Wall" will also incur one procedural per shot fired

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 27 rounds, 135 points
TARGETS: 12-1IPSC, 3-PP,
SCORED HITS: Best per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES:

The "hallway" is set up on the sidewalk of the smaller bay. T8 and T9 are set up next to the berm. Part of the walls will be the orange construction fencing

RO NOTES: All walls are considered solid and go from the ground to infinity.

Lemons or Limes

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Paul Schleider

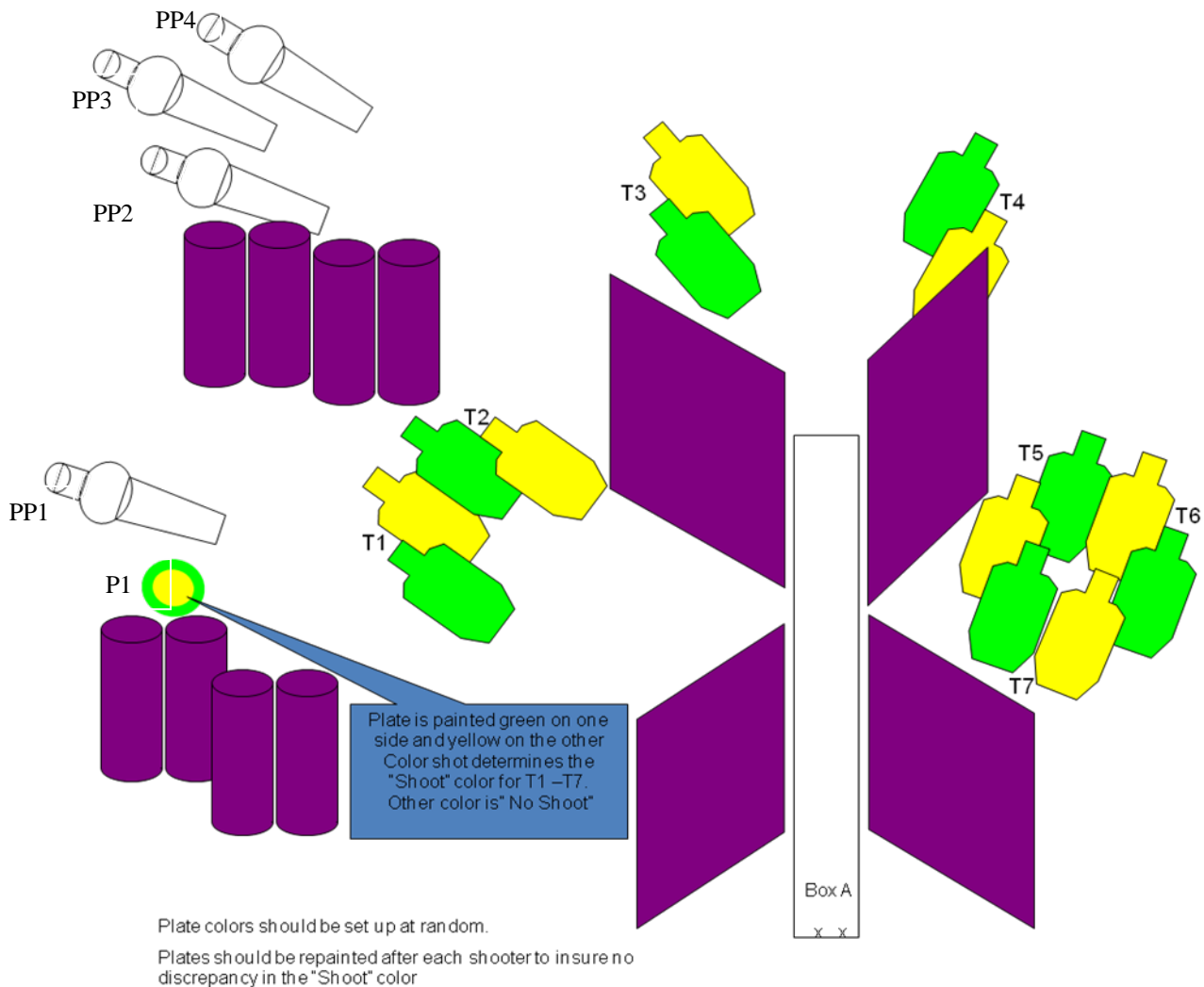
START POSITION: Standing erect in Box A Feet on Xs, arms hanging naturally at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

All targets are paired one Green and one Yellow. Plate P1 is Green on one side and Yellow on the other. Upon hearing start signal Engage P1. The Color engaged becomes the "Shoot" color and the other color becomes the "No Shoot" color. Engage the remainder of the target while staying within Box A

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 19 rounds, 95points
TARGETS: IPSC, PP, USP
SCORED HITS: Best per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES:

Set P1 randomly and insure the shooter cannot observe color until engaging target. PP2-PP4 should not be seen until the shooter passes the second set of barricades.

RO NOTES:

Remember to note color of plate and repaint plate after each shooter.

Close Quarter Standards

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** John Wells

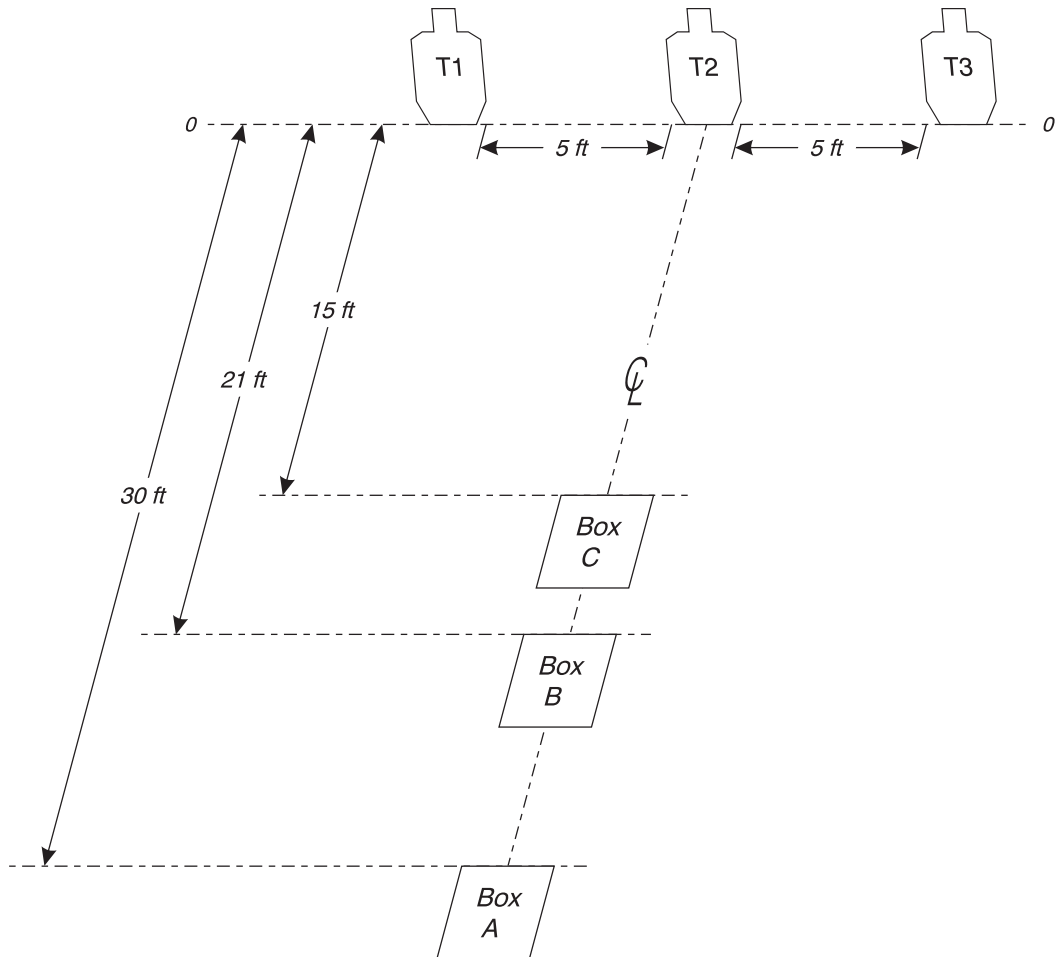
START POSITION: Standing in appropriate shooting box facing targets with both wrists above respective shoulders in surrender position. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

- String 1. Upon start signal, from Box A, engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target, then make a mandatory reload and from Box A re-engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.
 - String 2. Upon start signal, from Box B, engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target using strong hand only.
 - String 3. Upon start signal, transfer gun to weak hand and from Box C engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target using weak hand only.
- Jams may be cleared with both hands.

SCORING

- SCORING:** Virginia Count, 24 rounds, 120 points
- TARGETS:** 3 IPSC
- SCORED HITS:** Best 8/paper
- START - STOP:** Audible - Last shot
- PENALTIES:** Per current edition of USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.
Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: All boxes are 3 feet by 3 feet. Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders.
