## December 2008

Merry Christmas to each of you! I hope the holidays are bringing you and your family joy and happiness! We have a match this Sunday that may not bring you either...but it sure is gonna be fun.

Paul has once again put together some great stages for us and we will be shooting a couple of side matches. I really like Stage 3 that we sort of stole from the Coleman club, theirs is even bigger with more targets...The Coleman Classifier they call it...I've never shot anything like it and I am very curious to see how the scores will look.

The four match stages will have a round count of 96. We will have a rifle side match after the regular match that will combine stages 1 & 2, this will be about 42 rounds. Our other side match will be a Turkey Shoot, with a few twists of our own...

The Turkey Shoot will be open to everyone shooting the match. There will be three prizes, a Turkey, a Ham and a Pie.

Scores will be done during the match and winners announced when they are done. The three winners will have their pick in turn... 1<sup>st</sup> place will be well, first; second prize will go to the shooter whose score is closest to 50%, and the final prize will be awarded to the last place shooter. So, what is the stage? Two pieces of steel at 50 yards, two shooting positions, hit, not drop, one steel from each position. Nothing to it!

Only rule is that optical sights will not be allowed, irons only. We will shoot this stage first before the match begins, so I need everyone to get there early to help us set-up. Shooters meeting will be at 9:45, we will start shooting at 10 AM.

The weather forecast looks like it will be a great day for shooting. Bring a friend, or some of your family. The stages we have this month will be a lot of fun to shoot and fun to watch as well.

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:**

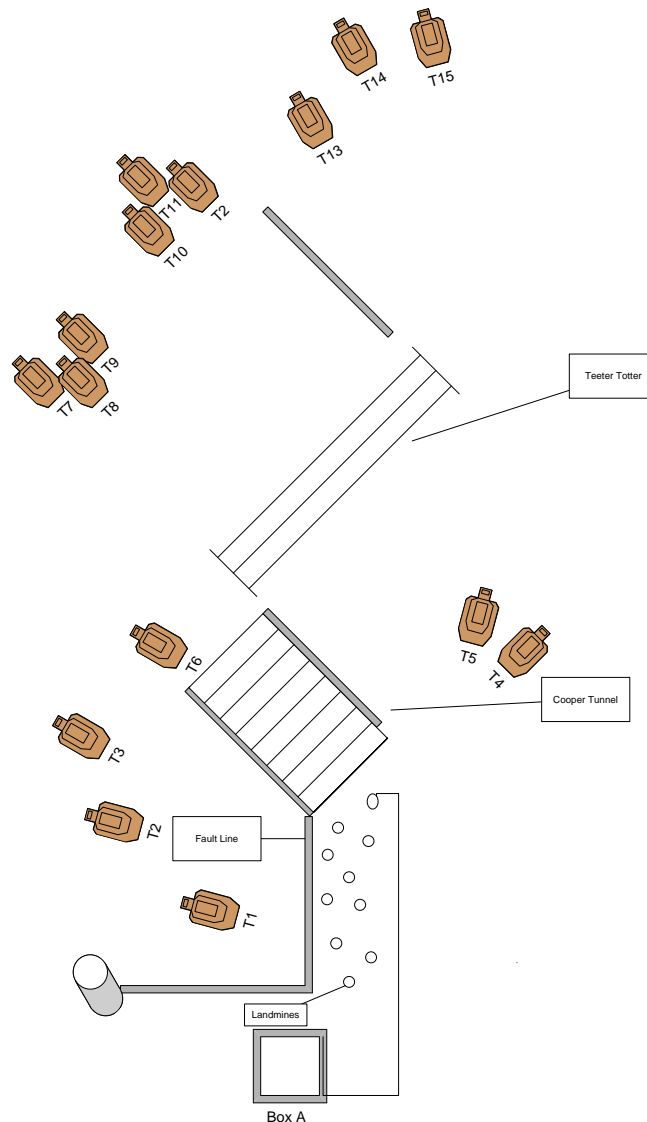
**START POSITION:** Standing erect in Box A, arms hanging naturally at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

## STAGE PROCEDURE

Starting in box A engage targets as they become visible.  
-10 procedural for each broken landmine (clay pigeon)  
The Cooper Tunnels walls go from ground to infinity.  
You cannot shoot through or over the walls.  
Failure to cross the teeter totter will incur -20 procedurals.

## SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 30 rounds, 150 points  
**TARGETS:** IPSC, PP, USP  
**SCORED HITS:** Best per IPSC, steel down = 1A  
**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10  
No-shoot hit. -10  
Miss. -10



## SETUP NOTES:

Randomly space 10 clay pigeons in path for landmines. T6 is a 45 laydown tgt.

**RO NOTES:** Procedurals for the teeter totter may be waived the discretion of the RM for shooter who feel they may not be able to safely cross it per section 10.2.10.2 2008 rule book

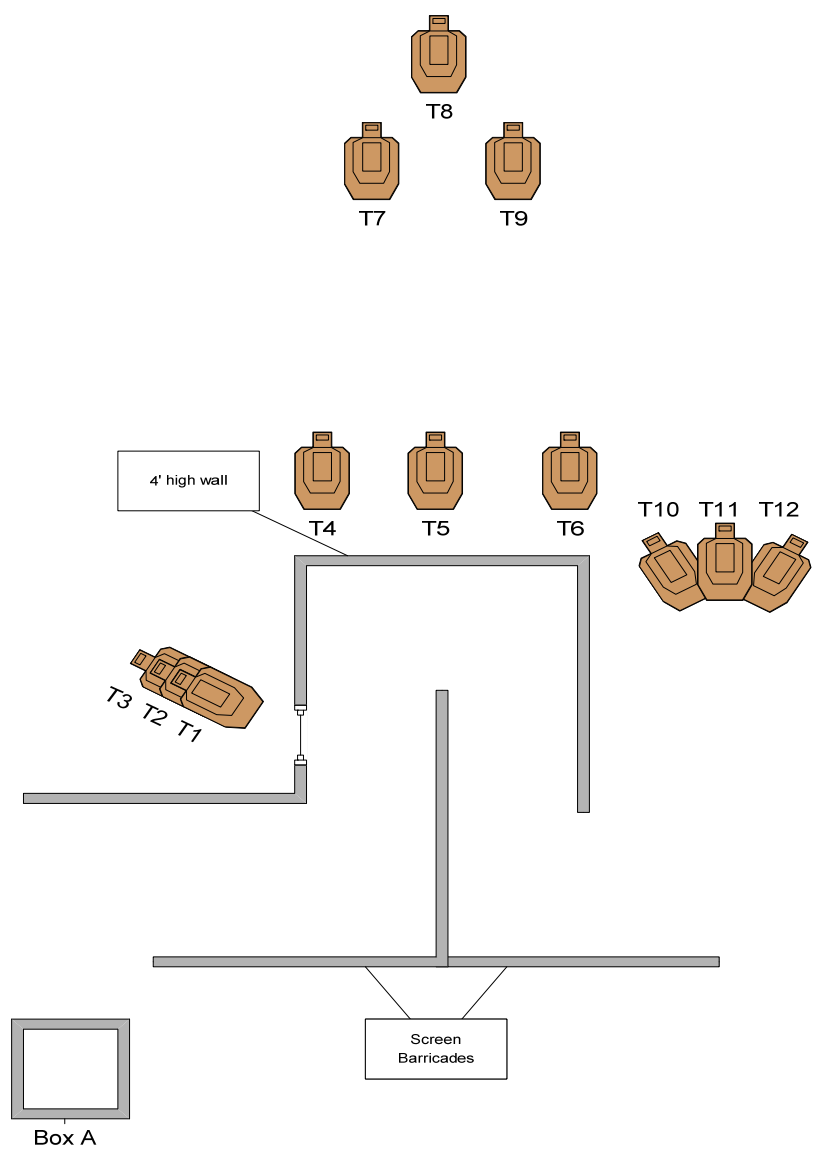

STAGE PROCEDURE	SCORING
Engage targets as they become visible.	<b>SCORING:</b> Comstock, 24 rounds, 120 points
Be careful not to break the 180 when backing up	<b>TARGETS:</b> 12 IPSC
	<b>SCORED HITS:</b> Best per IPSC,
	<b>START-STOP:</b> Audible - Last shot
	<b>PENALTIES:</b> Procedural. -10
	No-shoot hit. -10
	Miss. -10

To make it easier to RO use a T post and tape for the center dividing wall.

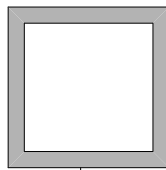
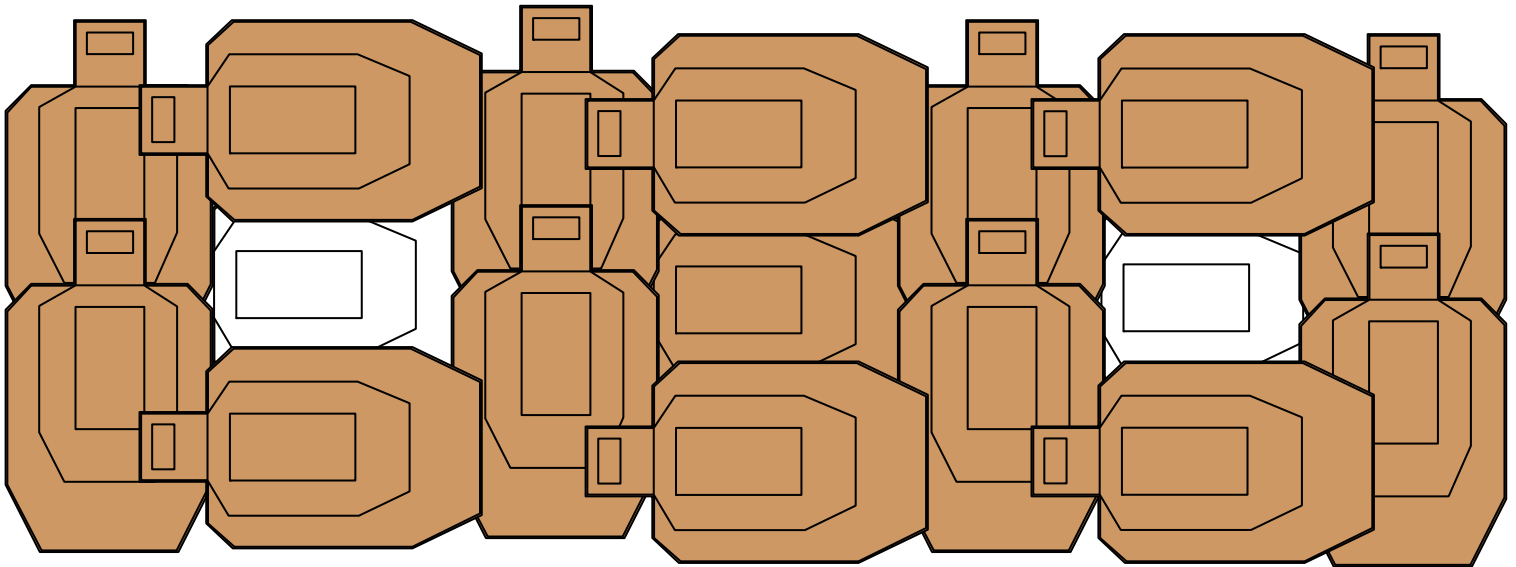

# Front Sight

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** P.R. Metcalf—Modification by US Design Team

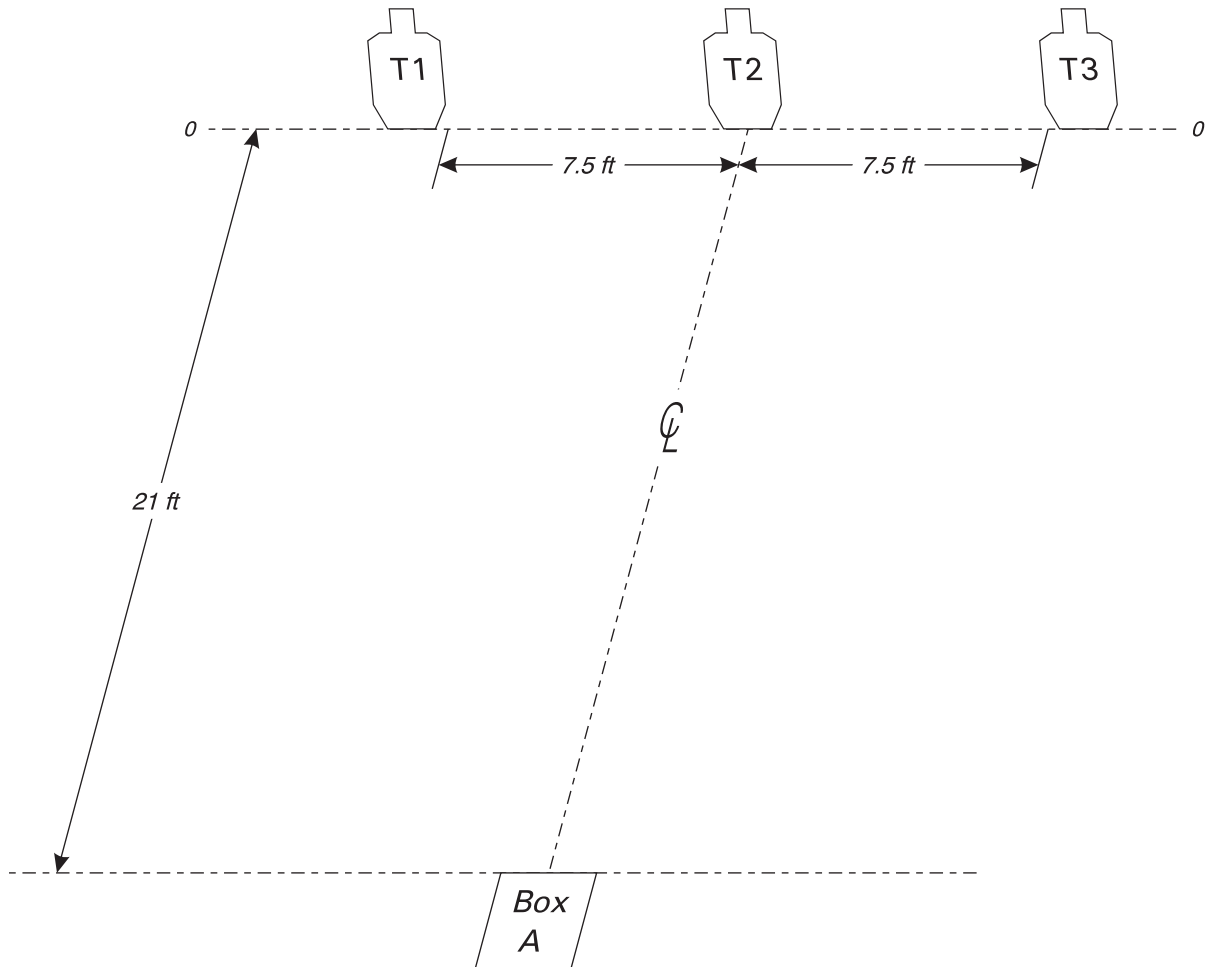
**START POSITION:** Standing in Box A, both arms hanging relaxed at sides or both wrists above respective shoulders - shooter's choice. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

### STAGE PROCEDURE

- String 1. Start facing uprange. Upon start signal, turn, from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.
- String 2. Start facing targets, hand position opposite of string one, upon start signal, from Box A, engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.

### SCORING

**SCORING:** Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 points  
**TARGETS:** 3 IPSC  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 4/paper  
**START - STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.



**SETUP NOTES:** Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet. Angle T1 and T3 to face shooting box.
