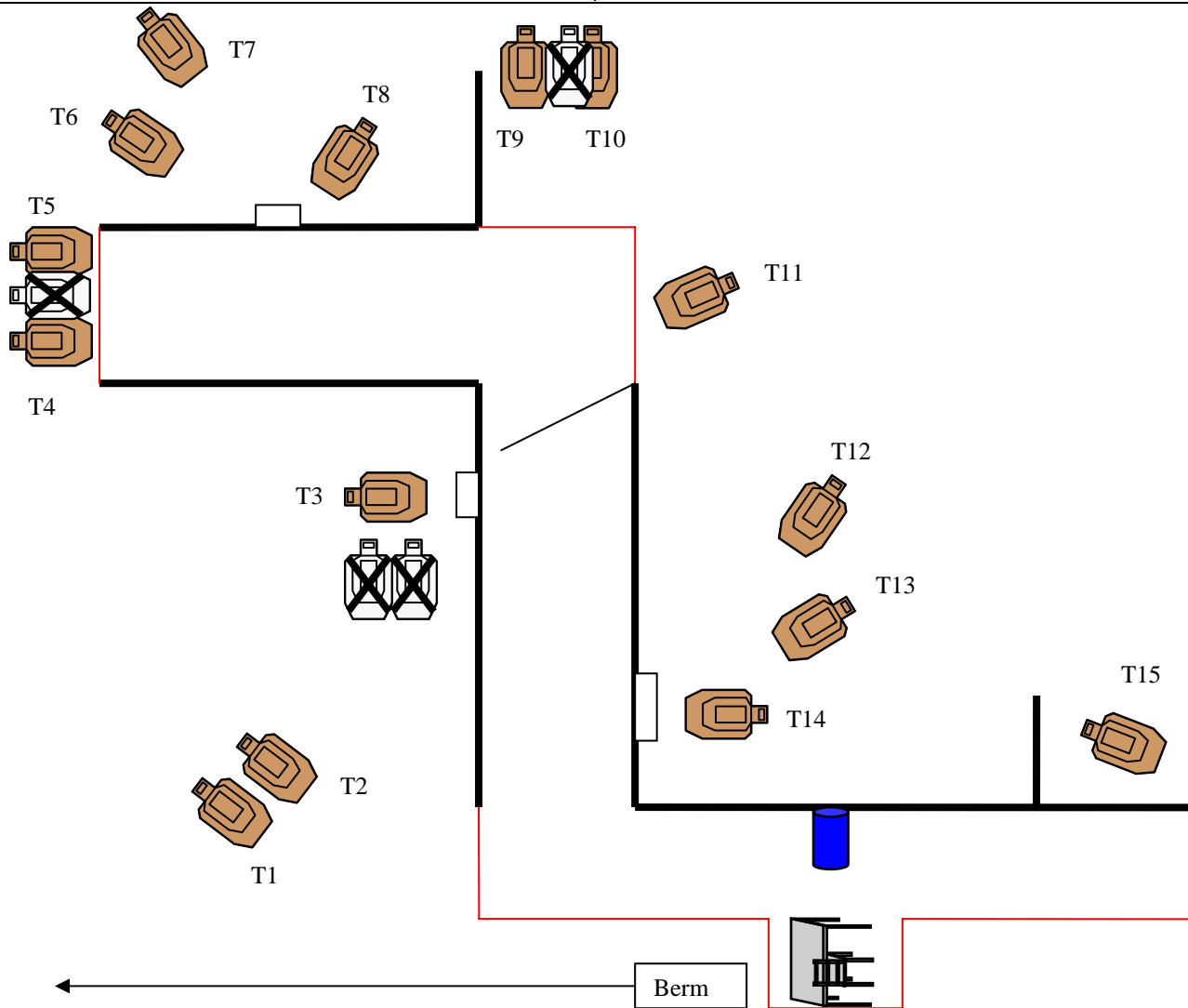
START POSITION: Setting at the table, knee's under the table with elbows on the table and hands on the side of your head. Gun is lying on the barrel unsupported and flat with hammer down unloaded. All ammo will be on barrel.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal retrieve gun and all ammo for the stage from barrel and engage targets as they become visible while remaining within the fault lines.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 30 rounds, 150 points
TARGETS: 15 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



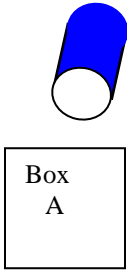
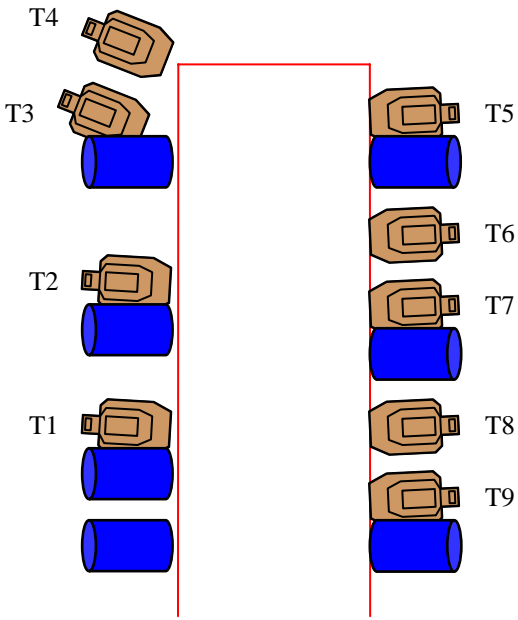
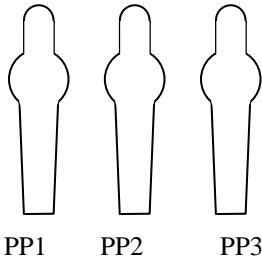
SETUP NOTES: T3, T8, T11, T14 & T15 are 45 degree targets.

START POSITION: Standing in Box A with hands flat on the top of barrel. Gun is loaded in holster per ready condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2	
<p align="center">STAGE PROCEDURE</p> <p>Upon start signal engage P1-P3 through the barrel while standing in Box A. Engage all other targets as they become visible while remaining within the fault lines. Steel must fall to score.</p>	<p align="center">SCORING</p> <p>SCORING: Comstock, 21 rounds, 105 points TARGETS: 9 IPSC, 3 PP SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A START-STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Procedural. -10 No-shoot hit. -10 Miss. -10</p>

Don't Miss Your Plate

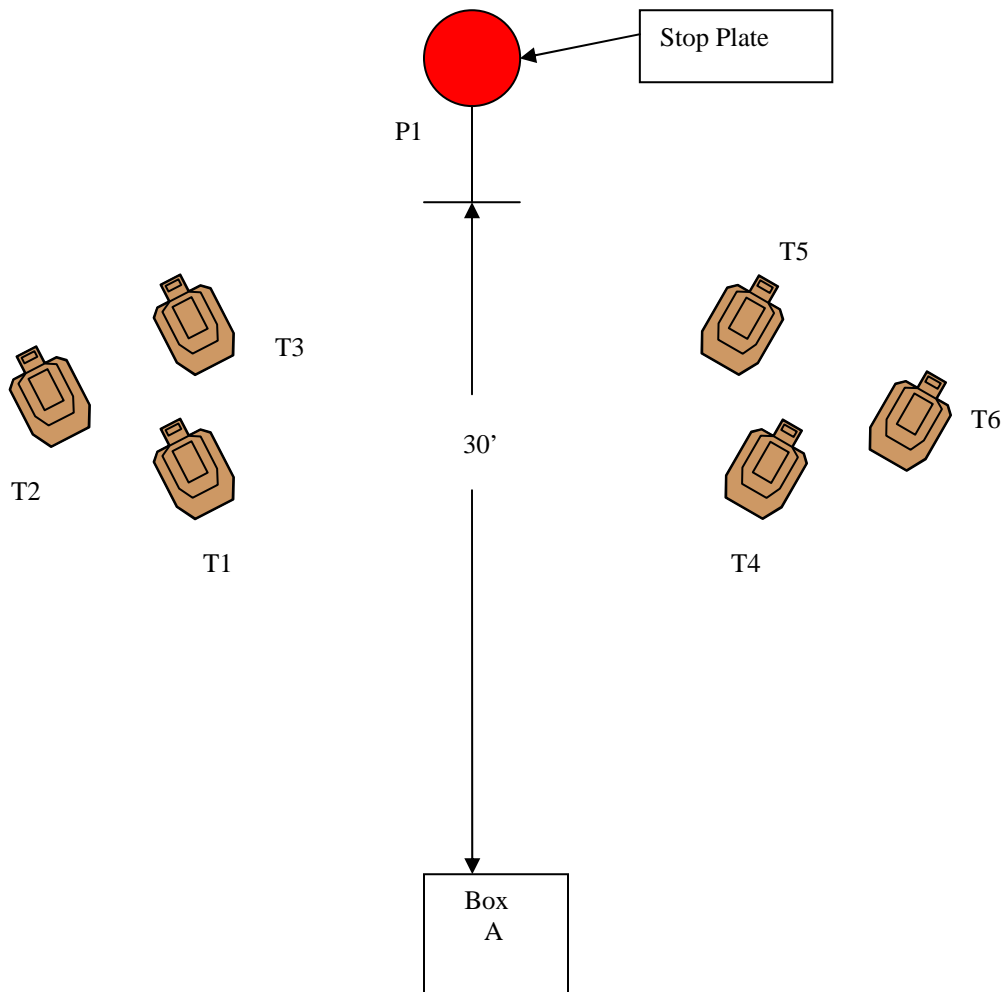
START POSITION: Standing in Box A with hands above respective shoulders at surrender facing down range. Gun loaded in holster per ready condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal engage targets as they become visible while remaining in Box A. Mandatory reload between L & R array of targets. P1 is a stop plate and is shot last. Plate must fall to score.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 13 rounds, 65 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC, 1 Plate
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Set stop plate about 3' off ground.

Peek-A-Boo No-shoots

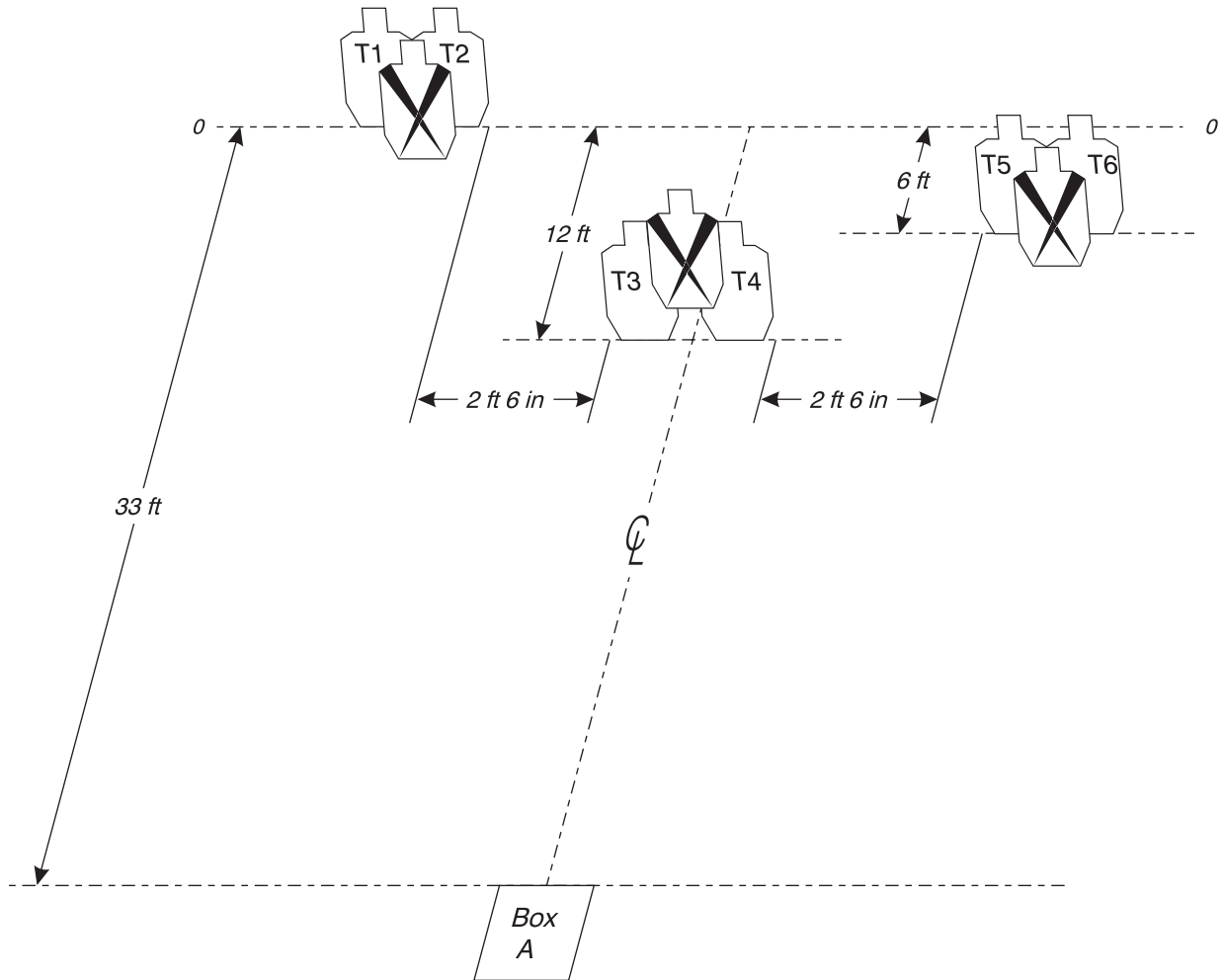
START POSITION: Standing in Box A facing targets with both arms hanging relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, from Box A, engage T1-T6 with one round each in any order, perform a mandatory reload and from Box A, engage T1-T6 with one round each target.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.
Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: Set targets T3 and T4 to 3 feet high at shoulders. T1, T2, T5, and T6 are set to 5 feet high at shoulders. Set no-shoot at T3-T4 array so lower shoulder corner is even with top of targets. Top of no-



shoots on the other two arrays are set to lower shoulder corner of the target arrays. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet. No-shoot on target T3 and T4 is centered on center line. T1, T2 and T5, T6 are butted edge to edge.
