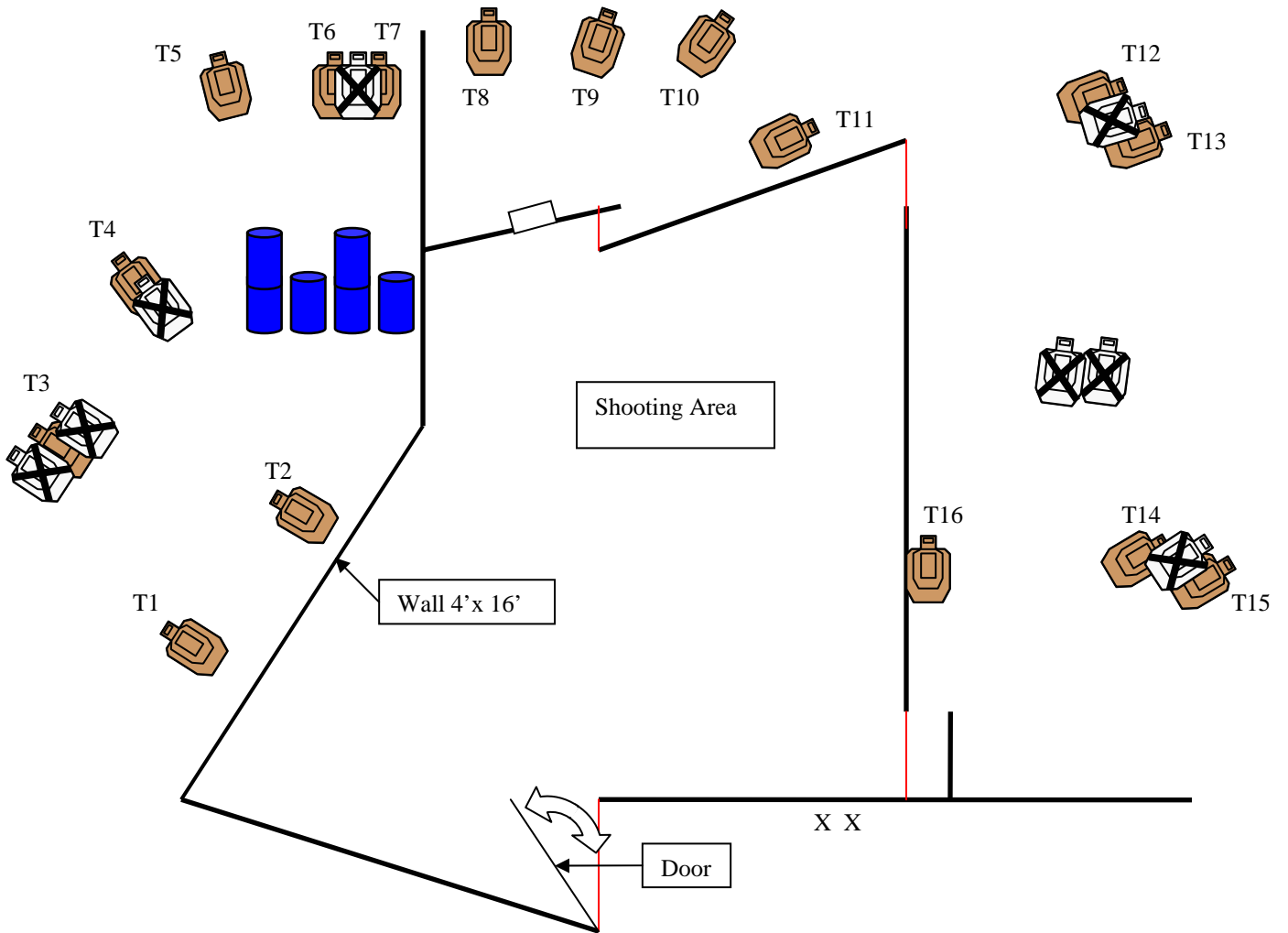

START POSITION: Standing on the X's with back and shoulders flat against the wall. Gun loaded in holster per ready condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2 All Ammo on shooters belt.

<p>STAGE PROCEDURE</p> <p>Upon start signal enter the shooting area through the door only and engage targets as they become visible while remaining behind fault lines.</p>	<p>SCORING</p> <p>SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points TARGETS: 16 IPSC SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A START-STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Procedural. -10 No-shoot hit. -10 Miss. -10</p>

SETUP NOTES: T1, T2 & T16 is 45 degree target.
 T3 & T4 set at 4' to shoulders.

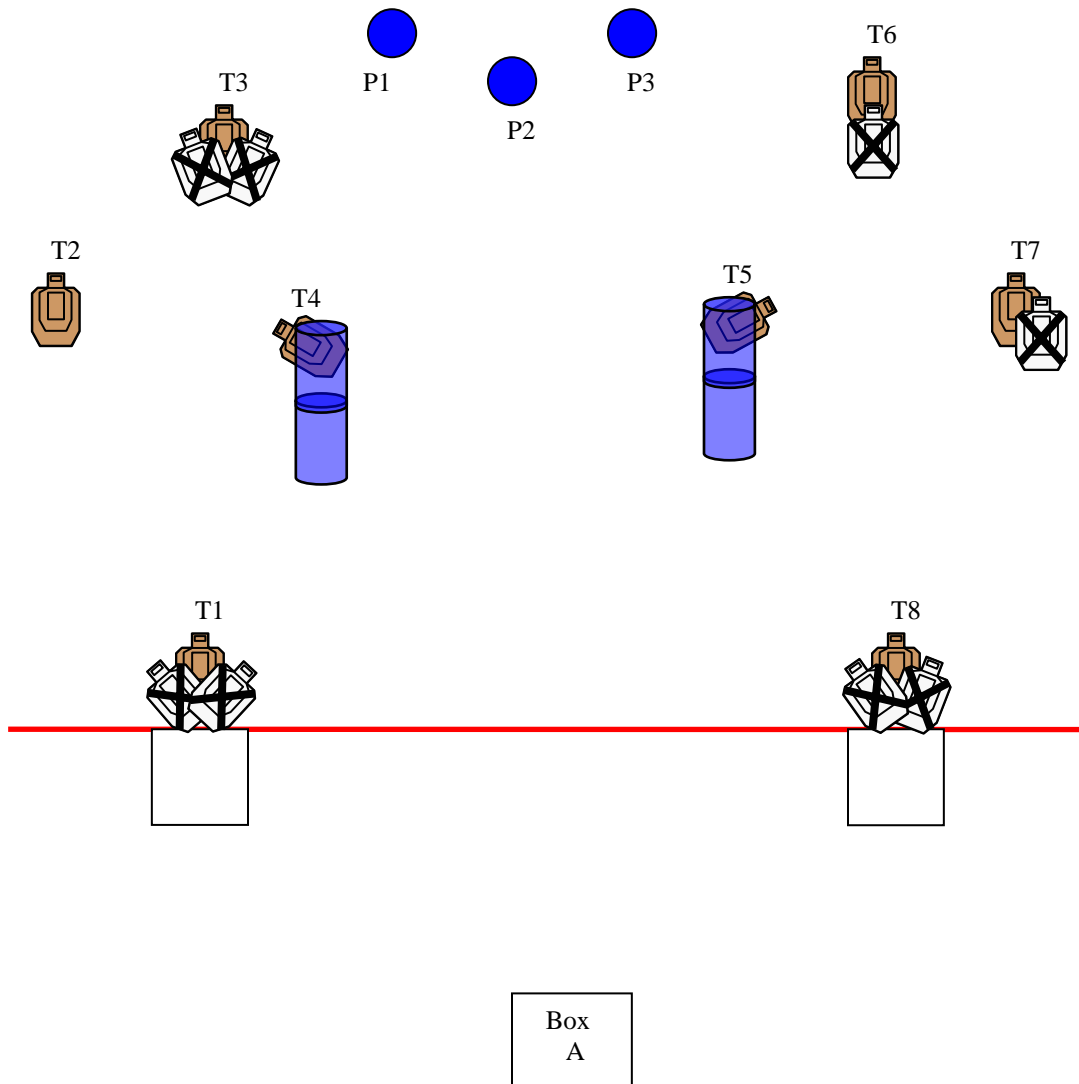
START POSITION: Standing in Box A facing up range with hand on top of your head. Gun loaded in holster per ready condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal engage targets as they become visible. Shooter must be in a box while engaging paper targets. Plates may be engaged at any time after start signal while remaining behind fault line. Plates must fall to score. Any paper targets engaged while outside a box will receive on procedural per shot fired.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 19 rounds, 95 points
TARGETS: 8 IPSC, 3 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: T1 & T8 are 45 degree targets. T4 & T5 are standard height hidden behind barrels.

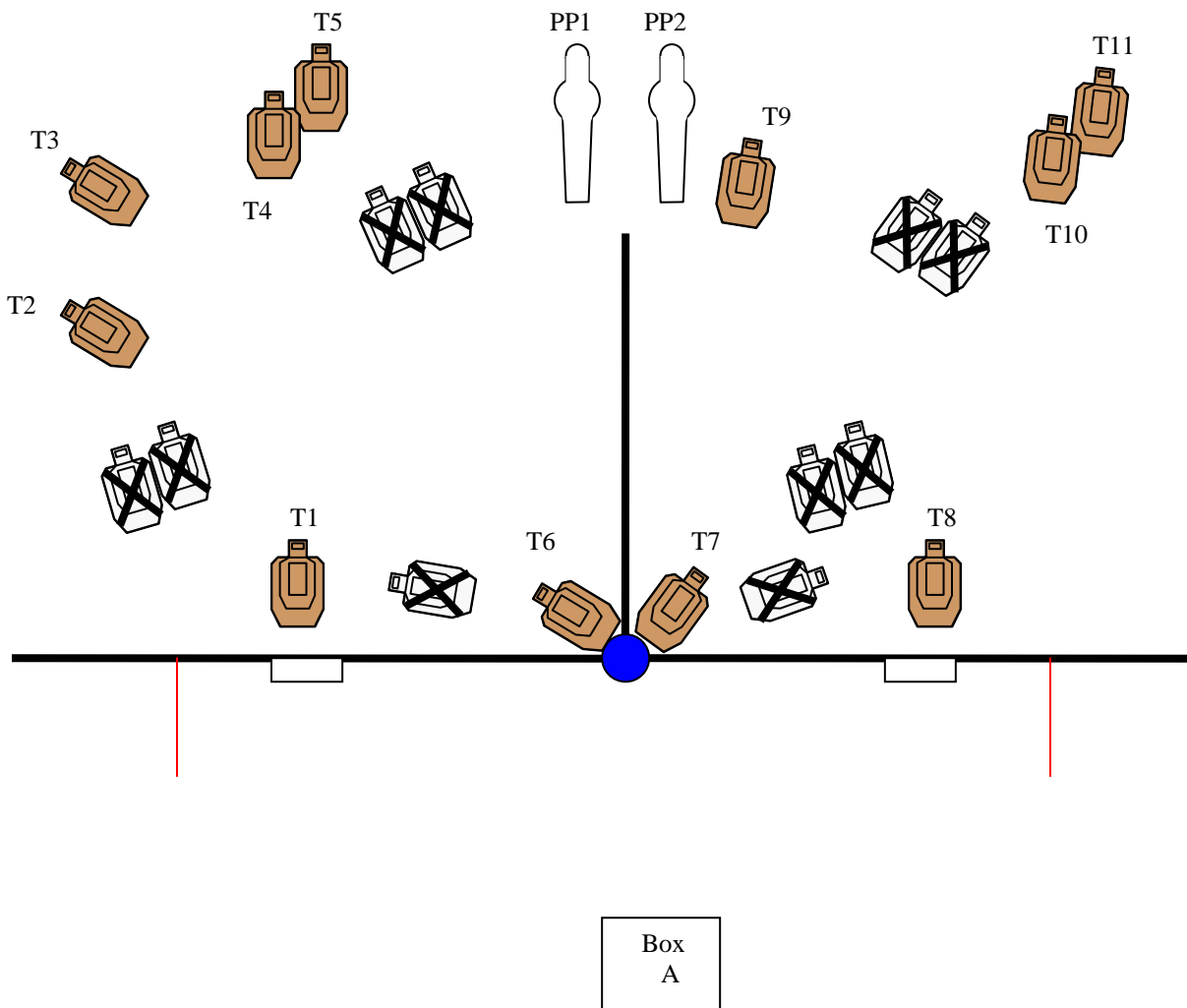
START POSITION: Standing in Box A facing up range with hands relaxed at sides. Gun is loaded lying on barrel unsupported with safety on. Extra ammo is on shooters belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal engage each target as they become visible while remaining within the fault lines. Steel must fall to score.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 24 rounds, 120 points
TARGETS: 11 IPSC, 2 PP
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: T1, T6, T7 & T8 are 45 degree targets. No shot targets are to block targets only.

Triple Play

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Larry Smith—Modifications by US Design Team

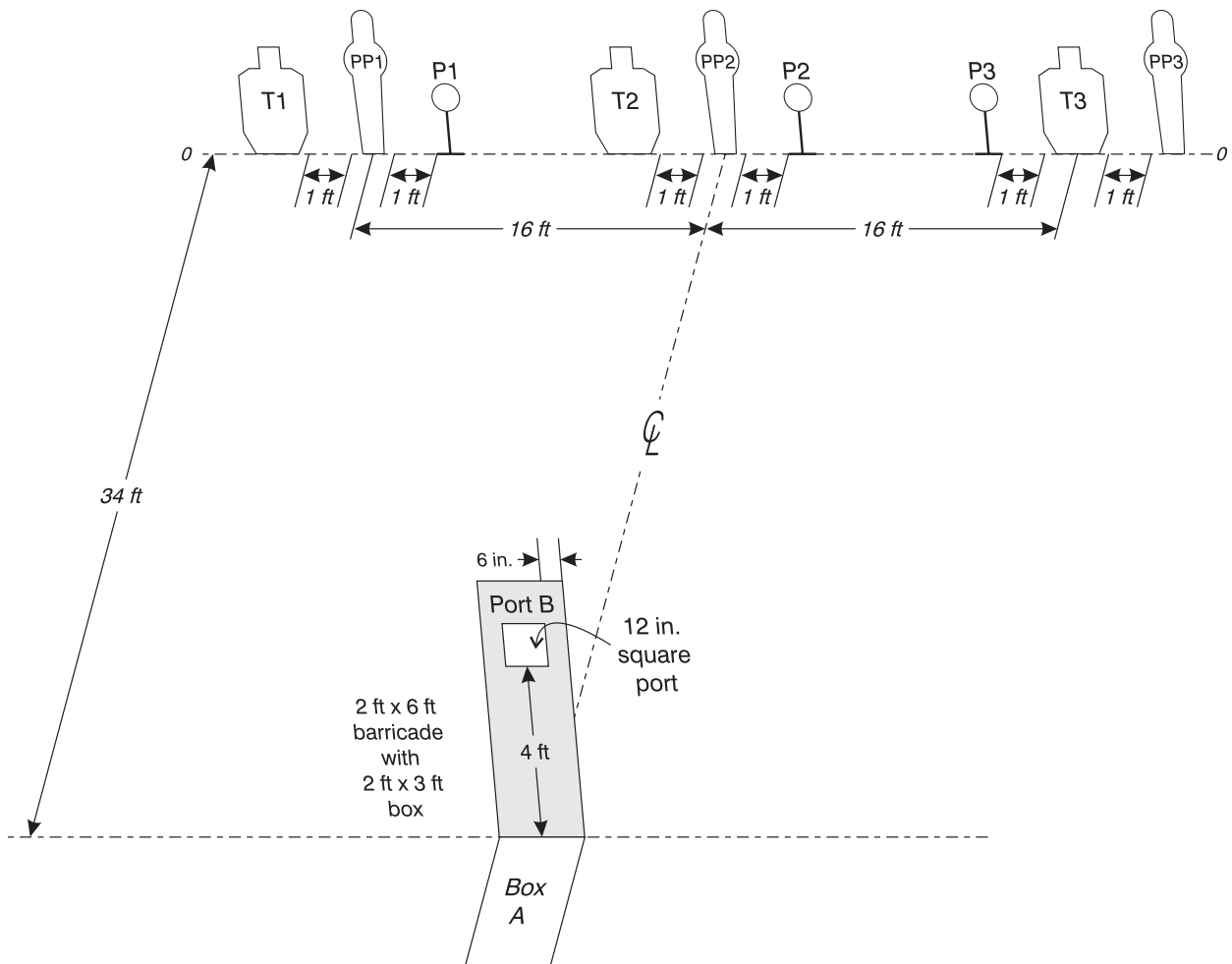
START POSITION: Standing in Box A facing barricade with both arms hanging relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, from Box A, engage only T1, PP1 and P1 from the left side of the barricade, perform a mandatory reload and engage only T2, PP2, and P2 through Port B, perform another mandatory reload and engage only T3, PP3 and P3 from the right side of the barricade. Arrays may be engaged in any order.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 3 IPSC, 3 Pepper poppers, 3 8" plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper, KD = 1 A
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.
 Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: Set targets so they are at right angles to the shooter. Paper targets are 5 feet high at shoulders. Plates are set at 2 feet above ground on standard plate stand.
