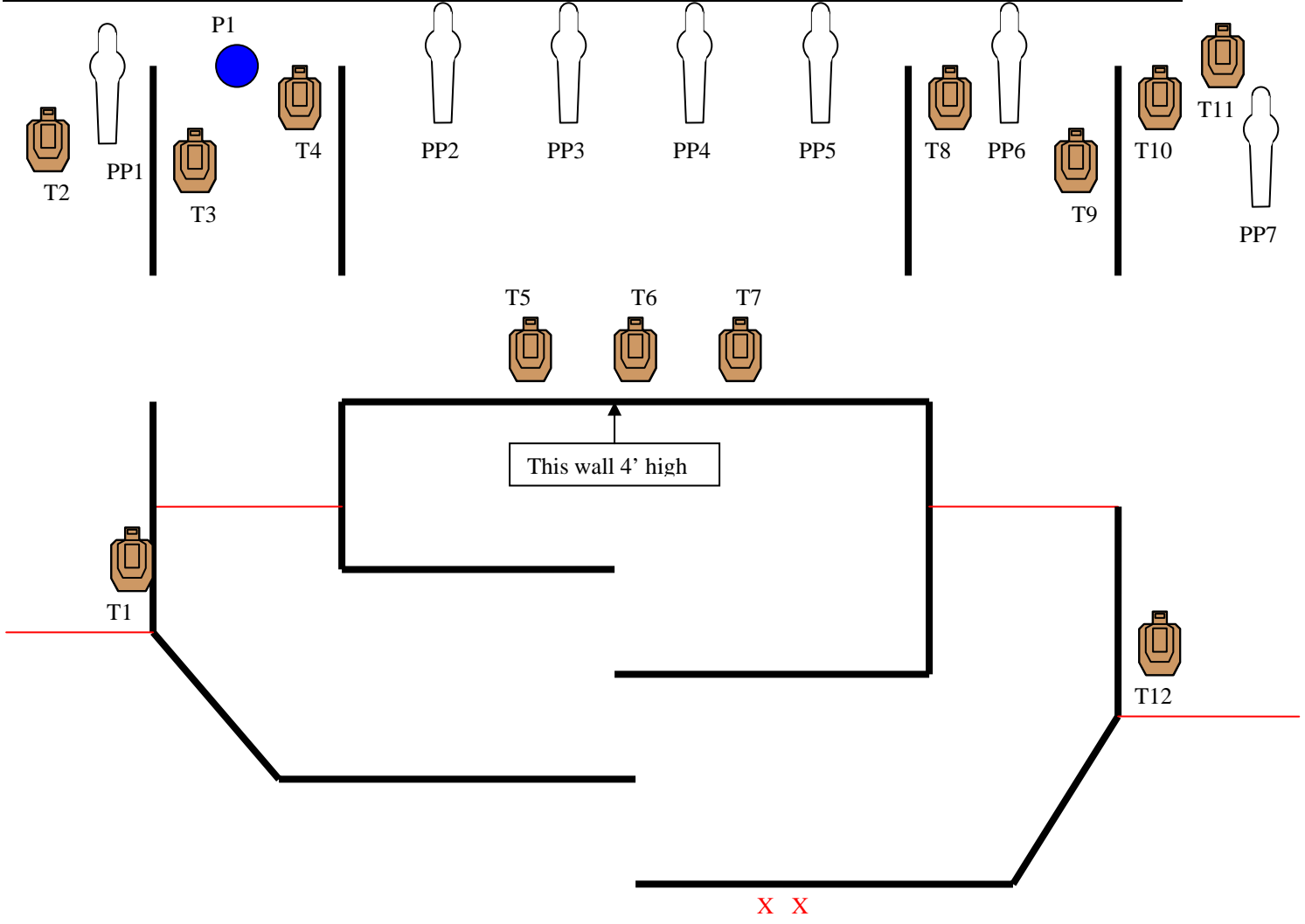

START POSITION: Standing on the X's with both hands flat on the X's on the wall. Gun is loaded and in holster per ready condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2

STAGE PROCEDURE	SCORING
Upon start signal engage targets as they become visible while remaining within the shooting area and not crossing the fault line for any reason. Steel must fall to score.	<p>SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points</p> <p>TARGETS: 12 IPSC, 7 PP, 1 Plate</p> <p>SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A</p> <p>START-STOP: Audible - Last shot</p> <p>PENALTIES: Procedural. -10 No-shoot hit. -10 Miss. -10</p>



SETUP NOTES: T1, T5, T6, T7, T12 are 45 degree targets. P1 is set 2' off ground.

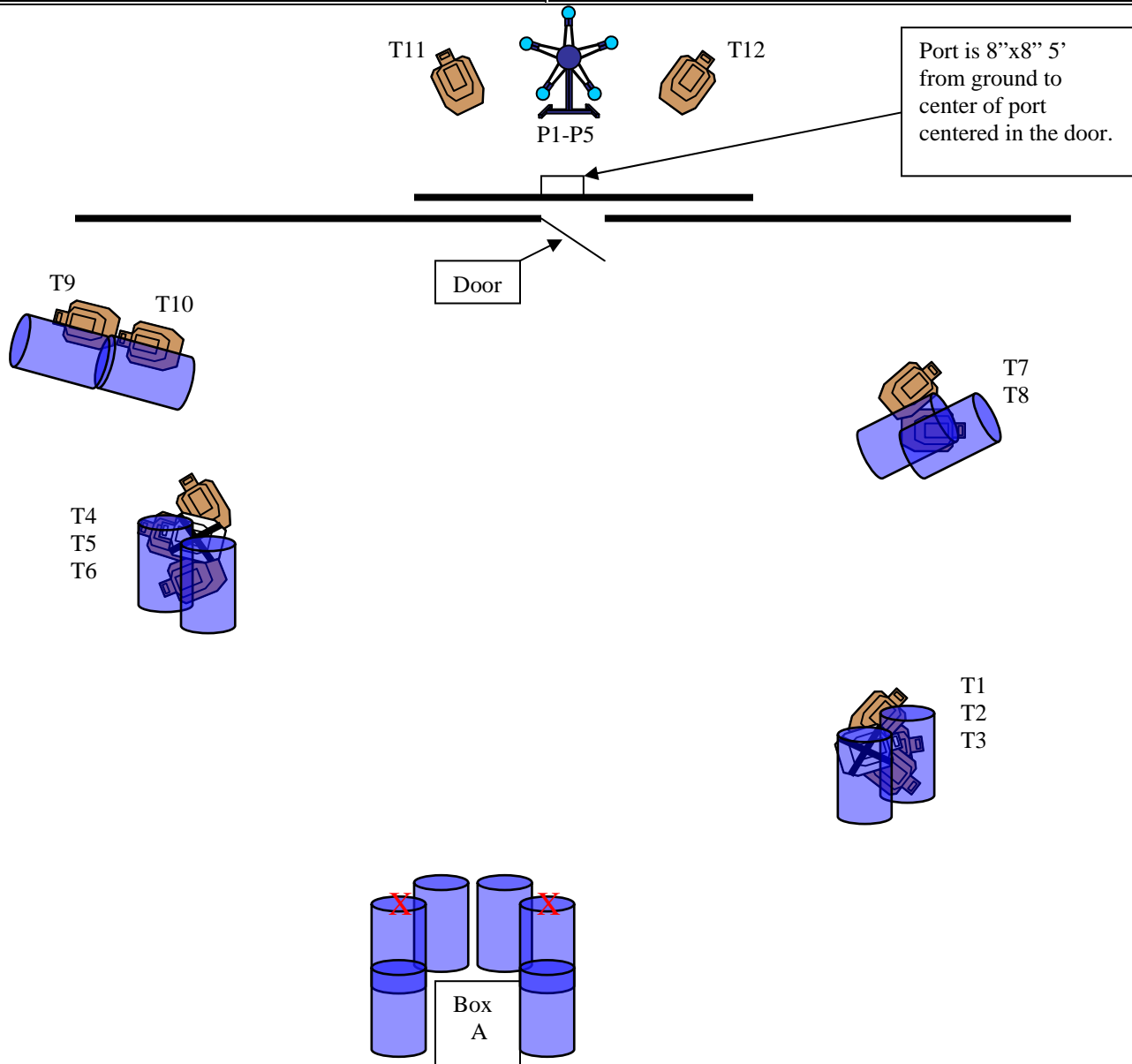
START POSITION: Standing in Box A facing down range with left hand flat on the X on top of the left barrel and right hand flat on top of the X on right barrel. Gun is loaded and in holster per ready condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal engage targets as they become visible. T11, T12 & star must be shot through the port. Steel must fall to score.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 29 rounds, 145 points
TARGETS: 12 IPSC, 5 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: T1 – T8 and T13 are 45 degree targets. Star is set minimum 21' from wall.

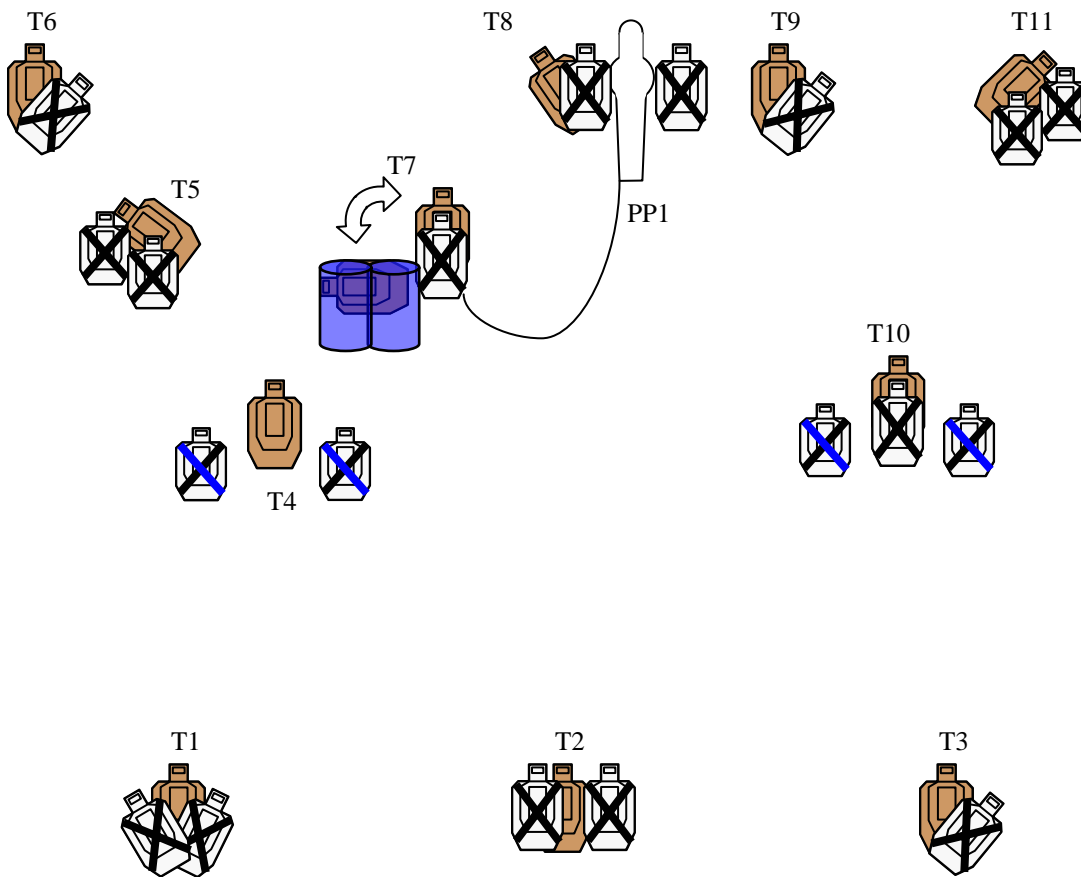
START POSITION: Standing on the X's of shooter's choice facing down range with hands on top of your head. Gun loaded in holster per ready condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal engage targets as they become visible while remaining behind the fault line. Steel must fall to score.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 23 rounds, 115 points
TARGETS: 11 IPSC, 1 PP
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10

SETUP NOTES: T1, T2 & T3 are 45 degree targets. T7 is swinging target activated by PP1. No shoot targets with blue stripe are to block angle view of target only.

Take Your Choice

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Skipper Songy

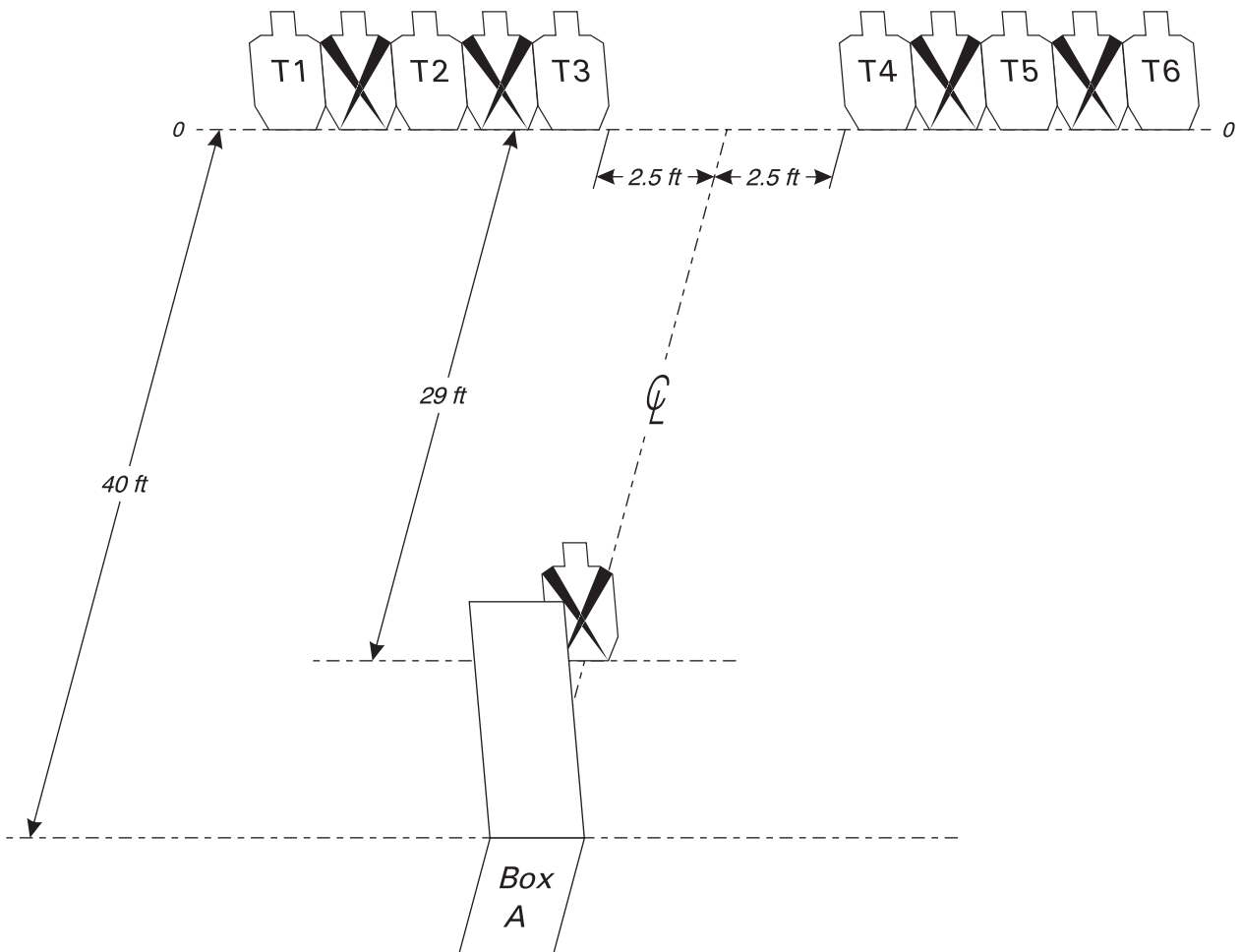
START POSITION: Standing in Box A, index finger and thumb of each hand touching, with hands placed flat on barricade at eye level. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Engage only T1-T3 from the left side of the barricade and only T4-T6 from the right side of the barricade. Upon the start signal, from Box A engage only the appropriate targets from one side of the barricade then make a mandatory reload and from Box A engage only the appropriate targets from the remaining side of the barricade.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.
Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: Set targets to 5 feet high at shoulders with targets butted together. Shooting box is 2 feet by 3 feet behind barricade 2 feet wide and 6 feet high. Center no-shoot in front of barricade on centerline of stage.
